Cowboys win third game at Oberlin, 61-53

The Cowboys stayed close through three quarters and took control in the fourth to win their third game of the season, 61-53, on Friday against the Red Devils

Tonight the Cowboys are at Max Jones Fieldhouse at 7 p.m. to play the Burlington Cougars. The Cougars are 7-6. The win on Friday gives the Cowboys a 3-12 record and drops Oberlin to 1-13.

Coach Don Smith said it was good to get the win, and he was pleased that some of the young players got a chance to play and stepped up to help the team win.

"We played one of the better games of the season," he said. "We thought during the game we had a chance because we did better in rebounds.

"Had some good play from those who came in off the bench and played well to get us back in the game in the second half," he said.

Smith said he changed to a 1-3-1 zone in the final quarter and it seemed to work well.

The Cowboys stayed close in the first quarter and the score was tied several times and each team had leads of one or two points until the last 20 seconds when Oberlin hit two baskets to lead 19-15 at the

In the second quarter Cowboy Brock Wilkens got into foul trouble and was on the bench, but Cowboy Blaine Luther came in and helped the Cowboys close the gap with Oberlin leading by one, 33-32, at half time. The Cowboys outscored Oberlin 17 to 14 in the second

The second half started with Oberlin taking a three-point lead, but the Cowboys stayed close and actually retook the lead twice in the quarter and there were two ties. The Red Devils managed to retake the lead and held a narrow 46-44 lead at the end of the third quarter.

The Cowboys tied the game and took a two-point lead in the first two minutes of the final quarter. The Cowboys were able to push the lead charity stripe. to 54-46 before Oberlin scored. The


offensive rebounds.


