The Lady Trojan girls played well, with five of the six shooting their all-time lowest scores in tournament competition, said Miles Ladenburger, head coach. Jessica Leiker shot her lowest score of 94 on the second day of the tournament with a 36-hole total of 198, placing 8th, and Alex Owens shot a 99, on day two with a total of 207, placing her 10th in the Alicia Allen shot 210, and Holly Kibel shot 219, both shoot-

ing their lowest scores in competition. Christy Colson shot a 226. (All 36-hole totals). The Lady Trojans place 3rd as a team, 9-strokes behind

Barton County. Dodge City placed first.
