

Cowgirl golfer qualifies for nationals

A former Cowgirl golfer and two others from the Colby Community College Lady Trojan team qualified for the Women's National Championship to be held May 17-20 in Daytona Beach, Fla.

Chelsie Gausman, a 2009 Goodland High School graduate, finished tied for first in the Region VI championship golf tournament held April 19-20 at Carey Park Golf Course in Hutchinson.

Gausman led the tournament after the completion of play on Monday, shooting an 89. After completing 36-holes Chelsie was in a tie for first with Barton County's Rachel Strecker who shot an 86 on day two, with a 36-hole total of 176 to tie Gausman. Gausman lost in a play-off to Strecker, who made par on the first playoff hole.

The Colby team finished third in the Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference with Gausman, Jessica Leiker and Alex Owens all placing in the top 10 of the Region VI championship tournament, and qualifying for the national tournament.

The Lady Trojan girls played well, with five of the six shooting their all-time lowest scores in tournament competition, said Miles Ladenburger, head coach. Jessica Leiker shot her lowest score of 94 on the second day of the tournament with a 36-hole total of 198, placing 8th, and Alex Owens shot a 99, on day two with a total of 207, placing her 10th in the competition.

Alicia Allen shot 210, and Holly Kibel shot 219, both shooting their lowest scores in competition. Christy Colson shot a 226. (All 36-hole totals).

The Lady Trojans place 3rd as a team, 9-strokes behind Barton County. Dodge City placed first.

Two Cowboys on Trojan team

At the same time the Colby Community College men's team was participating in the District VI Championship at Sand Creek Station Golf Course in Newton where the Trojan team finished fifth.

Two former Cowboy golfers were on the Trojan team with Mikey Doll tied for 24th with rounds of 78, 91, 77 for a total of 246. Ryan Gausman was 38th with rounds of 92, 94, 83 for a total of 269. Doll and Gausman are 2007 graduates of Goodland High School.

Chelsie Gausman was one of the stars on the Cowgirls golf team when Goodland won the Class 3A state championship in 2008. Gausman graduated from Goodland in 2009, and is a member of the Lady Trojans golf team and finished second in the regional championships.

Northwest Tech is a member of the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association and will be competing in the Central Plains Region. The season will consist of 10 rodeos, regional finals and the opportunity to qualify for the College National Finals Rodeo held annually in Casper, Wyo.
