

Rollover sends six to hospital

A one vehicle rollover about two miles east of the Edson exit on I-70 at 6:20 p.m. on Sunday sent six people to the Goodland Regional Medical Center and two adults were flown to Swedish Medical Center in Denver.

State Trooper Charlie Brattin, stationed at Colby, said the accident happened when the 1998 Ford Explorer driven by Victor F. Pantoja-Cano, 23, of Los Angeles, was driving east on I-70 east of the Edson exit when the vehicle crossed the passing lane and went into the median where it rolled an undetermined number of times. The Explorer then rolled into the west passing lane where it came to rest on its wheels facing west.

Sherman County fire and rescue were called to the scene and the Sherman County Ambulance ser-

vice transported Pantoja-Cano and passenger Beatriz Yanez, 30 of Los Angeles, to Goodland Regional Medical Center and the two were flown out to Swedish Medical Center in Denver.

Officials at Swedish Medical Center said Pantoja-Cano is in fair condition and Yanez is in serious condition.

Also injured in the accident and taken to Goodland Regional Medical Center were passengers Ray Torres, 7, Kate Pantoja, 2, Crystal Pantoja, 4, and Rose Pantoja, 4, all of Los Angeles. The condition of the four children is not known, and because they are minors Tina Goodwin, public affairs person at the Goodland hospital, said she could not release information under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).
