

# Cowgirls lose at Norton, play Holcomb tonight

The Goodland Cowgirls will be glad to be back at Max Jones Fieldhouse at 5:30 p.m. tonight when they play the Holcomb Lady Longhorns after losing to the Norton Lady Bluejays on Tuesday.

The Norton game was the fifth road game for the Cowgirls who finish with a 2-3 road record losing to Norton 39-29 on Tuesday to wind up the road trip.

Coach Andy Scheopner said the Cowgirls got off to a slow start at Norton and couldn't recover.

Late in the game the Cowgirls battled back to cut the lead to single digits, but Scheopner said the girls could never get over the hump.

"We look forward to getting back on the court against Holcomb tonight," he said.

The Cowgirls started the road trip in Holcomb on Jan. 14, for a Great West Activity Conference game, but the Cowgirls lost 56-46.

At the Hillsboro Trojan Classic the Cowgirls won the opening game over Republic County, 43-34, lost a tough one to Riley County, 36-34, and finished with a win over Hillsboro 55-50 for third place.

With the loss to Norton Tuesday the Cowgirls have a 6-5 record, and are in something of a win one, lose the next one pattern. Tonight's game is a short home break for the Cowgirls as they return to the road on Tuesday in Burlington, Friday in Ulysses and the next Friday, Feb. 11, in Colby.

Tuesday was a non-league game against the Lady Bluejays who the Cowgirls defeated 39-31 in the consolation championship of the Topside Tip-Off in December.

The Cowgirls controlled the opening tip from Ashley Archer to Jennifer Rome, but could not score. The first Norton basket came with 6:53 left to take a 2-0 lead. Thirty seconds later Archer hit 2 of her 18 points to tie it a 2-2.

The Lady Bluejays led 7-2 before Archer got another basket. Archer hit two free throws to make it 9-6, but Norton scored the next 6 before

Norton led 19-8 at the end of the first quarter.

Archer got a lay up to make it 19-10, but Norton hit the next 6 points to lead 25-10 with less than 4 minutes left in the half.

The Bluejays were taking their time and being deliberate in their plays to run time off the clock.

Cowgirl Jade Herl broke the scoring drought with a lay up with 1:18 left to make it 25-12, and that was the score at halftime.

The Cowgirls had 10 turnovers in the first half and Archer led with 8 points and Phillips and Herl each

had 2. Norton struck first in the second making it 29-12 before Rome hit a 3-point shot with 3:40 left to make it 29-15.

Archer hit two free throws and Herl hit one of two free throws to make it 31-18 with under 1 minute left. Norton hit again in the final seconds to take a 33-18 lead.

Archer got the first two Cowgirl point of the final quarter on to free throws to make it 33-20.

The Cowgirls began pressing and a steal by Berkley White made it 33-22. The Cowgirls stepped up the defensive pressure, but the shots wouldn't fall.

Norton had a 3-point basket and Archer answered for Goodland with a 3-point basket to make it 36-25 with 5 minutes left.

Archer hit one of two free throws with 2:52 left to make it 36-26.

The Cowgirls had to start fouling and Norton made 3 of 6 free throws in the final minutes to make it 39-27.

With 8 seconds left Archer got a lay up at the buzzer to make the final 39-29.

Archer led the scoring with 18 points and 12 rebounds. Herl had 4, Rome 3, and Phillips and Berkley White 2 each.

The Cowgirls shot 26.5 percent

(9-34) and hit 75 percent (9-12) of their free throws.

Three girls for the Lady Bluejays were in double figures with Tawni Griffey and Erin Terrell each hitting

12 and Dustlyna Sprigg 11. Caren Thompson had 4.

The Lady Bluejays hit 38 percent (16-42) but only 39 percent (5-13) of their free throws.
