

Cowgirls sweep opening games with Scott City

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The Goodland High School softball team won a double header against Scott City last Tuesday at Scott City. They won the first game 11-2 with Ashley Archer pitching. In the second game they won 22-5 with Hope Cochran pitching.

The next action for the team will be the Monday after spring break, April 4, with games at Liberal. The first home games for the Cowgirls will be Friday, April 8, against Hugoton.

In the first inning catcher Berkley White and outfielder Hope Cochran struck out, short stop Gabby Rangel made it to first base and third baseman Brianna White was out when her fly ball was caught by the third baseman. Of the first three batters for Scott City, two struck out and the other was out on a fly ball to the short stop.

when her flyball was caught by the short stop. Center fielder Kirsten Toppliff was also out. Scott City had

three up and three out.

In the third Cochran was out on a fly. Rangel and Brianna White hit

doubles. Gaydusek and Phillips hit singles. Rangel and Brianna White scored. Siruta and Kirsten Toppliff struck out. The score was Goodland, 2-0. The first batter for Scott City was out on a pitcher first base combination. The next was out on a fly ball and the third struck out.

In the fourth inning, Berkley White scored on a double, Cochran on a single. Gaydusek walked. Archer hit a double. Scott City has three up and three out. The score was Goodland 4-0.

In the fifth inning Berkley White, Cochran, Rangel, Siruta and Kirsten Toppliff scored. Scott City didn't score. Goodland leads 9-0.

Siruta was the only scorer in the sixth. Scott City hit their only two runs. The score was Goodland 10-2.

Brianna White scored in the seventh with Scott City scoring none. The game ended Goodland 11-2.
