

# Four bring Kansas Kids state medals home

Four of the 12 who traveled to Topeka over the weekend came home with medals including one State Champion, two who finished second and one who finished fourth in the Kansas Kids Folkstyle Championships held at the ExpoCenter.

Ian Bonsall was the champion at 165 pounds in the 14 and under division. Finishing second was Tyler Gastineau at 160 pounds in the 14 and under division, and Tanner Gastineau was second in the 84 pound class of the 12 and under division. John Peden finished fourth in the 155 pound class of the 14 and under division.

Goodland placed sixth in the 14 and under group with the three wrestlers placing in that division. Goodland was 29th in the 12 and under division with the one wrestler placing.

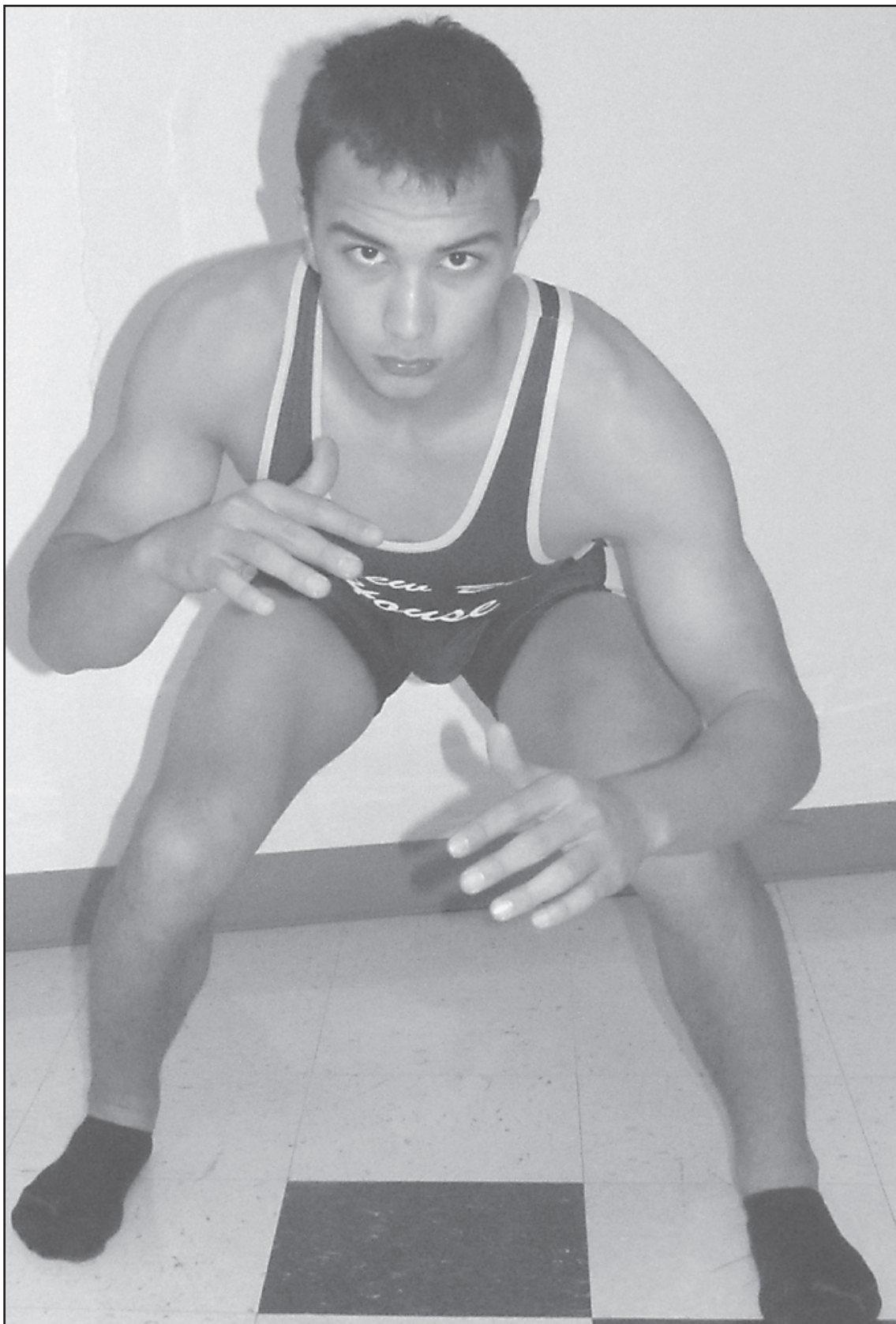
