governing body. All members shall continue in office until their successors are appointed and qualified. Vacancies occurring during any term shall be filled by the governing body of the City for the remainder of the unexpired term.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper as provided by law.

SECTION 5: This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect Sixty-one (61) days after the last publication thereof unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on

the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED AND ADOPTED this 4th day of April, 2011, by a two-thirds vote of the members of the governing body of the City of Goodland, Kansas.
