

Goodland places first, second in 9-10 track meet

The Cowboys finished first in the 9-10 track meet held at the Goodland High School track on Monday, and the Cowgirls finished second.

The Cowboys finished first of 10 teams attending the track meet winning with 156 points. Second was Ulysses 106; third Scott City 66; fourth St. Francis 51; fifth Cheylin 46; sixth Colby 36; seventh Norton 33; eighth Burlington 24; ninth Hoxie 17; and 10th Atwood 11.

The Cowgirls finished second with 114 points behind the 122 for Scott City in first place. Third was Burlington 85; fourth Ulysses 54; fifth Colby 46; sixth Hoxie 31; seventh Atwood 26; and eighth Norton 17.
