## Fishing limits ending at Bonnie lake

Colorado is preparing to drain Bonny Reser-
voir tohelp the state comply with the Republican River Compact with Kansas and Nebraska, the state Division of Wildlife is lifting bag and possession limits on sport fish at the southeastern Yuma County reservoir effective Sunday.

to drain the reservoir to satisfy a legal obligation to drain the reservoir to satisfy a legal obligation
to release all the water to Kansas and Nebraska. The result will likely be the loss of the entire fish population.
population.
"Right now, it is unknown how longlin
to drain the lake, but it looks like this might be the lastyear for fishing at Bonny," said Area Wildlife Manager Cory Chick. "The division wants anglers to have an opportunity to harvest as
fish as possible before the water is gone.
fish as possible before the water is gone.
"From now until the fall waterfowl hunting closure takes effect, anglers are encouraged to harvest as many fish as possible."
The water level at Bonny is about 18 feet below
normal, he added, but the boat ramp at the state park is still usable
Aquatic Biologist Gary Dowler said recent sampling indicates the overall number of sport
fish is good, particularly for walleye and catfish.
Numerous flathead catfish over 10 pounds were landed last year, he said, and sampling efforts revealed a strong population of walleye with many fish over 20 inches. However, he expects

Officials said the division has developed a plan to move some of the sport fish to other reservoirs.
Based on our most effective methods, we ypically move no more than 10 percent of the fish," said Chick. "That is why we would like anglers to have an opportunity to try to catch as many as they can."
Anglers must have a valid Colorado fishing license, and must fill out a two-part form indicating the number and species of fish kept when
they complete their fishing. Forms are available at self-service kiosks at the entrance points. All legal methods of fishing will be allowed, including trotlines, jugs and seines. Commercial angling is prohibited, however. Boating and
onditions create a danger to fishermen. The reservoir will reach its lowest level wh he water drops to a point even with the outtak alve, the division says. That is expected some time in the fall or winter. "We won't know the final depth of the reservoi until that happens, but it doesn't look like the boa
ramps will ever be usable again past this year," Chick said.
Bonny was created in 1951 when the U.S.B eau of Reclamation built a flood control dam o the South Fork of the Republican River. Recreation on the reservoir, and the land on he east end of the lake, is managed by Colorad State Parks. The Division of Wildlife manage he recreational use on the lands adjacent to th ark and below the dam as the South Republic Check the Colora.
