

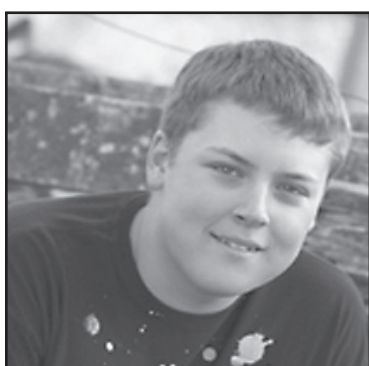
# Five to get money

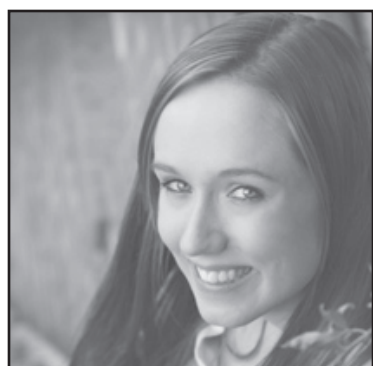

Five Goodland High School seniors have received scholarships from the Dane G. Hansen Foundation at Logan.

The students are Dayelle Waugh, Hazen Deeds, Brock Wilkens, Nick Thomas and Tyler Jones.

Waugh will receive one of fifty Hansen Scholar awards. The award was for \$3,000 for one year and may be renewed for an additional

year. Students must maintain a 3.0 grade point average and write a letter describing progress towards educational goals.

Deeds and Wilkens will receive Hansen Student awards. There were 100 of these awards and are

for \$2,000 and may be renewed for one additional year.

Two seniors will receive vocational education awards. Tyler Jones and Nick Thomas received the one-year award of \$2,000 for their education.

This is the 36th year for the scholarships. Students must demonstrate proficiency in verbal and writing skills plus their academic records, test scores and community service.

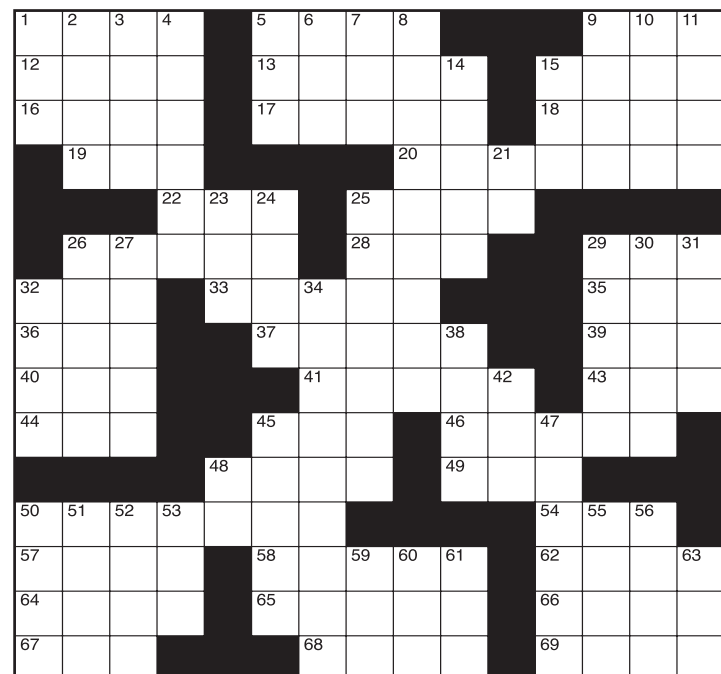
