

Cowboys sweep Holcomb in doubleheader

The Cowboys improved to 9-5 on Thursday sweeping a doubleheader from Holcomb 14-4 and 15-0.

The Cowboys will be in Hays Thursday, Friday and Saturday for the Western Diamond Classic. The games on Thursday begin at 2:45 p.m.

In the first game on Thursday the Cowboys took a 1-0 lead in the first inning with Ryan Hillmer scoring on a double by Austin Avelar.

The Cowboys exploded in the second inning for nine runs and batting around with nearly everyone scoring and Reed Bellamy hitting two doubles for three runs batted in.

The Cowboys added two runs in the fourth and two in the fifth to win 14-4.

Garth Helton was the starting pitcher getting four strikeouts in his two innings and giving up no runs. Taylen Smith came in to pitch in the third inning. He gave up three runs in the third inning and one in the fourth, but struck out the final batter in the fifth inning to give the Cowboys the 10-run win.

In the second game the Cowboys again got an early 1-0 lead in the first inning. They added four runs in the second and batted around in the third adding seven runs to lead 12-0.

The Cowboys added three runs in the fourth to win 15-0.

Avelar was the winning pitcher getting six strikeouts and not allowing any runs in his four innings.

Ryder Kling scored four runs in the second game and two in the first game. He had a triple and a single in the second game and a single in the first game.

Hillmer scored three runs in the first game and two in the second game. He had a single and a double in the first game and three singles in the second game.

Dallas DeLaRosa scored a two runs in the first game and had a single. In the second game he scored two runs and had a double.

Gunner Helton scored two runs in the first game and had two singles.

Devon Garrett scored two runs in the first game. He had a single in the second game, but did not score.
