# Mini Sprint Cars part of opening night at races

A total of 74 cars in six divisions raced for a crowd Saturday night in the first races of the season including the 1200 cc mini sprint cars from Colorado.

Race fans who have gotten used to seeing the winged mini sprint cars saw a change on Saturday with the sprint cars running without the wings this year.

Jay Sant (car 24) of Parker, Colo., said over the winter two 1200cc clubs in Colorado decided to merge, and decided to race half of the races with wings and half without wings. He said one club had always run with wings and the other ran without the wings.

The new Rocky Mountain Lightning Sprint Association had their first races at Fort Morgan before coming to Sherman County Speedway. Sant said he was lucky enough to win the first feature race at Fort Morgan, and it was a races with the wings on the car. He said it was his first race with the wing, and he felt it went better than he had expected.

Saturday at the Sherman County Speedway the cars ran without the wings and Sant finished third in the feature race.

Mat Martinez (61), who had finished 13th at Fort Morgan was the feature race winner on Saturday. Jeff Gieg (18) was second, and had been seventh in the previous race.

The Colorado sprint club brought 12 cars, but three had some problems and did not finish the feature race including Paul Babich (69), Chris Crowder (26) and Troy Ullery (1).

Other feature race winners on Saturday included Brady Coen (3) in the IMCA Modified division leading




