

Cowboys win Class 3A regional golf tournament

The Cowboys added to their great golf season winning the Class 3A regional tournament held Monday at Sugar Hills Golf Course and qualified the team for the Class 3A state tournament to be held on Monday in Salina.

"We had another great day with five of our six golfers medaling," said Coach Terry Daise. "I believe if we play up to our capabilities we can contend for the state title."

"Best I could tell five out of the top 10 golfers from last year are back. Besides us, team wise I believe Wichita - Collegiate is probably the favorite. They have won the last five Class 3A state titles."

The Cowboys placed five in the top 10 with Gage Ihrig the top golfer on Monday with a 76 with 38 on each half of the 18 holes. George Bellani was second with 77 having a 36 on the first nine and a 41 on the second nine. Gannon Ihrig was fourth at 82 with a 38 on the first nine and a 44 on the second nine. Joel Linin was seventh at 84 with 42 on each nine holes. Tyler Jones was 10th with an 88 with a 41 on the first nine and 45 on the second nine.

Tanner Jones tied for 20th with a 94. He had a 45 on the first nine and 49 on the second nine.

Goodland won with a team score of 319. Phillipsburg was second 341, Smith Center third 353, Lakin fourth 363, Southwestern Heights fifth 363, Norton sixth 395, Scott City seventh 408, and Holcomb eighth 438.

today at 3:30 p.m. outside the west end of the high school. The Cowboys will depart for Salina early Sunday morning.

The Cowboys had won the Great Western Activity Conference title on Thursday with five finishing in the top 10.

The Class 3A state tournament will begin at 8 a.m. on Monday at Salina Municipal Golf Course with each foursome teeing off 10 minutes apart.

The top flight of golfers will tee off about 9:30 a.m. Cowboy Gage Ihrig will be in the top flight including Mark Cunningham, Ellsworth; Joseph Lambert, Prairie Village-KC Christian and Sam Dunne, Wichita-The Independent.

Cowboy George Bellani will be in the third foursome of the top flight including Harrison Morris, Wichita-Collegiate; Tyler Stone, Council Grove and Seth Ray, Fredonia.

Cowboy Gannon Ihrig will be in the sixth flight including Patrick Maloney, Wichita-Collegiate; Devin Dick, Hillsboro and Howard Mahan, Fredonia.

Cowboy Joel Linin will be in the 10th flight including Caleb Brenning, Hutchinson-Trinity; Palmer Thompson, Silver Lake and Eddie Fahnstock, Wichita-The Independent.

Cowboy Tyler Jones will be in the 15th flight including Elliott Money, Sedgwick; Adam Molleker, Marion and Hunter Midfelt, Erie.

Cowboy Tanner Jones will be in the 20th flight including Dane Purkeypille, Marion; Ryan Hoover, Phillipsburg and Cory Palmer, Wichita-The Independent.

The next batter hit a single and eventually scored. At the end of the inning runner were left on third, second and first. That made the score Larned, 4-0. When Goodland's turn to bat came up the had three up and three out.

In the fifth inning Larned hit a trip with was batted in by the next batter who hit a double. At the end of their turn they had runners on second and first at the end of the inning but now lead 5-0. The Cowgirls ended their turn with a runner on first.

Larned added four runs to their score in the six inning while the Cowgirls remained scoreless, 9-0.

In the seventhinning Larned added one final run. They won 10-0.

"I hated the final game's outcome but we still had a great year," said Coach Tess Smith. "I'm proud of how hard the girls fought. We're going to miss this group of seniors but Cowgirl softball looks good for next year."
