## Bridge repairs began Monday on I-70 east of Colby

Work to repair three I-70 bridges in Thomas County began on Monday, said a Kansas Department of Transportation representative.

The three bridges are located near the Mingo Interchange (Exit 62), approximately eight miles southeast

of Colby.

Contractors will apply a polymer overlay across the driving surface of each bridge. "The overlay is a cost-effective way of sealing a bridge deck and existing cracks, therefore extending the life of the

bridge," said KDOT Construction Engineer Mathew Withington – of the Atwood office.

I-70 traffic will be reduced to one lane, while the bridge work is underway. All three bridges should be completed within two weeks,

weather permitting, Withington said.

Driver as asked to use caution, pay attention to the work zone signs, and respect workers when driving through a road work zone. Slow down and "Give 'Em A Break,"

he said.

KDOT awarded the construction contract – totaling \$96,205 – to Wildcat Concrete Services of Topeka. The bridge repair projects are funded by T-WORKS, the transportation program passed by the Kansas

Legislature in May, 2010.
