Breast care center opens at Hays Medical

Hays Medical Center has opened a comprehensive Breast Care Center to provide services to women who are at high risk for breast cancer. The center is strategically located alongside the Hadley Foundation Imaging Center's breast imaging services at 2501 East 13th St. Building I at the Oak Park Medical Complex in Hays.

The center focuses on four main areas: breast cancer prevention, risk assessments, genetic counseling and testing; management of precancerous lesions and non-cancerous breast issues; coordination of care with breast cancer treatment specialists and breast cancer survivorship.

It utilizes the services of the Hadley Foundation Imaging Center, a certified Breast Imaging Center of

Excellence. Digital mammography, ultrasound and DEXA imaging services are provided at the Oak Park location and are combined with the imaging services offered at HaysMed including stereo tactic ultrasound guided biopsy, breast MRI and ultrasound. Rounding out the services is the mobile digital mammography service provided at regional hospitals. Together, the Breast Care Center provides the most comprehensive breast care services available in the region.

Multidisciplinary breast treatment services include a dedicated patient navigator to assist patients in coordinating their care, management of benign breast disease and precancerous conditions and access to a fellowship trained breast oncologist, board certified surgeons,

medical oncologists, radiation oncologist and plastic and reconstructive surgeon.

The staff includes medical director Anne. O'Dea, MD, Breast Oncologist; A. Nicole Spray, Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner, Michelle Beyer, CNA and Linda Ruder.

For those who have completed breast cancer treatment the center offers a formal survivorship program that provides dedicated surveillance and management of long-term side effects. Survivorship services include long term monitoring for breast cancer survivors and access to breast cancer survivorship clinical trials in partnership with University of Kansas Medical Center and the Midwest Cancer Alliance.
