Relda Louise Dutton

Relda Louise "Lou" Dutton, 89, Littleton, Colo., 1939 graduate of Sherman County High School, died Sunday, May 29, 2011 in Littleton due to cancer.

She was born Aug. 11, 1921, to Leonard and "Bessie" Sexson Jones in Goodland. Her father was a railroad engineer for the Rock Island Railroad, while her mother stayed at home raising their seven children.

After graduating from high school she attended Kansas State University, transferred and received a teaching certificate from Fort Hays State University the following year. She taught fourth grade and music at Edson, but decided the world of business better suited her. She returned home and worked at Goodland Savings and Loan Bank.

On Dec. 23, 1945, she and Paul Dutton were married in Smith Center. He worked with his father in road construction until the business was sold and his father retired. Mrs. Dutton encouraged and supported him as he attended dental school at the University of Missouri at Kansas City. In 1959 the couple moved to Colorado to open a new dental practice.

After moving to the Denver Metro Area she began working for Terrydale Realty Trust as a building manager at 101 University Boulevard at Cherry Creek. In 1972 she enrolled in the Institute of Real Estate Management. Three years later she became the first woman in the

U.S. to received the designation of Certified Property Manager. In 1978 she was elected as the first woman in the country to serve as president of an Institute of Real Estate Management Northern Colorado Chapter No. 17. During her presidency the chapter was recognized as an exemplary chapter.

After 26 years in property management Mrs. Dutton retired but continued to work another 10 years as executive director for the local chapter of the Institute of Real Estate Management and received Emeritus status. After that she volunteered at the Jefferson County Election Commission.

Mrs. Dutton enjoyed listening to music, attending concerts, singing and playing piano and organ. She also enjoyed playing bridge, poker and "O' Eli."

Preceding her in death were her parents and her husband in May 2006.

Survivors include three daughters, Denise (Don) Richards of Lawrence, Dana (Steve) Smith of Appleton, Wis. and Janell (Mark) Wagner of Littleton, Colo.; a brother, Dr. Ben Jones of Burlington; and six grandchildren.

A memorial service was held at 1 p.m. on Saturday, June 11, 2011, at Horan McConaty Family Chapel, 3103 South Wadsworth Boulevard, Lakewood, Colo. A dessert reception followed the ceremony. Private inurnment will be in Goodland.

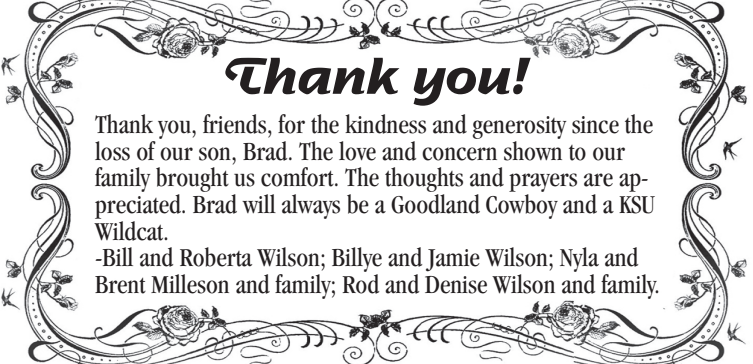
