For fishermen, Flint Oak offers both guided and non-guided opportunities on three beautiful lakes and Indian Creek. Indian Lake was initially stocked with 8,000 2-pound bass and 1,500 wipers that now weigh in at over 10 pounds.

The main lodge has 40 rooms and 80 beds. Occupancy for the entire facility is 140 people. Rooms range from "an old-fashioned bunkhouse" to deluxe accommodations with full baths.

In summertime, Flint Oak's facilities are open to the public for shooting sports, corporate retreats, weddings, company picnics, youth camps, reunions, charity events, fishing, nature trails and more.

Today, Flint Oak has more than 50 employees and 350 memberships, representing 29 states plus foreign countries. During 2010, more than 10,000 guests came to visit.
