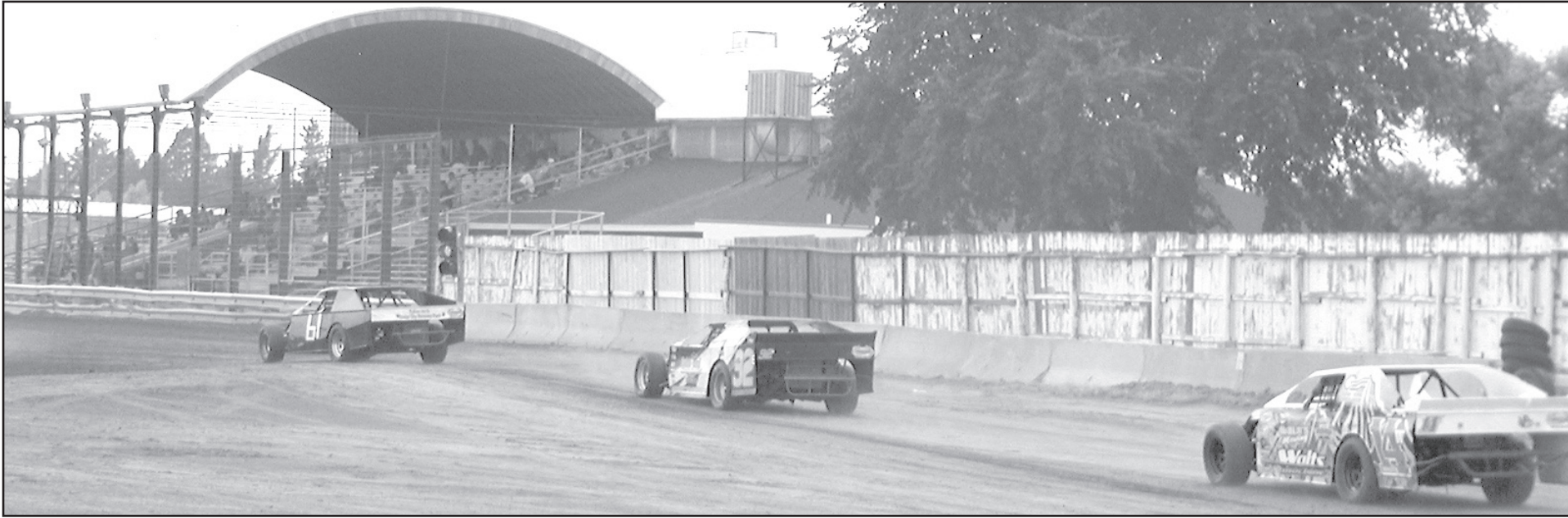


# Sherman Speedway races continue on Saturday



Race cars rolled onto the Sherman County Speedway on Friday for hot laps before the checkered flag dropped. The races were to make up for the rain out in June, but on Saturday most of the feature races were again rained out. The Sherman County Speedway will start with the postponed feature races on Saturday and then proceed to the regular scheduled races.

Sherman County Racing Association has been battling with Mother Nature to get rain delayed races completed, and will try again on Saturday to play catch up and have a full race card for Ice Cream Night.

The green flag will drop at 6:30 p.m. for the rain delayed feature races from last Saturday for the Modifieds, Sport Modifieds, Stocks and Econos before the regularly scheduled races.

The pit gates open at 2 p.m. Hot laps are at 5:30 p.m., and the pit gate closes at 5:30 p.m.

Make-up feature races from June 18 were run on Friday with Keith Stegman (19) winning the IMCA Modifieds. Darren DeLoach (21) was second, Chris Lueck (33L) third, John Fose (27) fourth and Adam Morris (8) fifth.

In the track points race posted so far DeLoach is leading with 76 just ahead of Nate Morris (7L) who has 75. Adam Morris is in third with 72 and Brady Coen (3) is fourth with 71. Chris Remetes (10) is fifth with 69.

In the IMCA Sport Modifieds feature Chris Heim (1) was the winner, and he is leading the track point standing with 77. Jacob Adler (18A) was second and he is a close second in the points race with 75.

Austin Walker (44) was third in the feature race, Steven Lewis (74) was fourth and Jeff Kerns (61) was fifth.

In the IMCA Stock Car feature Jeff Tubbs (37x) was the winner. Jason Schoenberger (6x) second, Ryan Wark (8) third, Nick Tubbs (737) fourth and Bruce Plumisto (01W) was fifth.

Plumisto is the current points leader with 76. He is ahead of Jason Rogers (37) and B.J. Wagoner (51W) who are tied at 75 points.

In the IMCA Hobby Stocks Angel Munoz (2M) was the winner and leads the points race with 80. John Peden (71+) was second, Jimmy Jenkins (97J) third, Raymond Dechant (1D) fourth and Joey Snethen (S98) fifth.

In the Econo Class Ryan Murphy (12M) was the feature winner. Jason Gray (32) was second. Gray leads the points race with 80.

Mike Meyers (37M) was third, Joe Harper (37) fourth and Scott McDonald (37x) fifth.

# Legion Zone tourney starts on Sunday

## Three Goodland boys qualify for national track meet

The Goodland American Legion team will open Zone 7 Baseball tournament play at 5 p.m. on Sunday at Norton against Trego.

The Goodland team goes in with a 6-7 record and Trego has a 8-14 record.

Goodland won two games over Ellis on Wednesday 10-9 and 7-3 at Memorial Field.

The other game on Sunday will have Norton (6-8) facing Osborne (1-9).

The second round games will be on Tuesday with Colby (14-12) playing the winner of the Goodland and Trego game at 5 p.m. In the other game Tuesday at 7 p.m. Smith Center (7-6) will play the winner of the Norton and Osborne game.

The losers of the first games will

play on Wednesday at 5 and 7 p.m. The tournament is double elimination, and the semi final games will be on Thursday with the losers playing at 5 p.m. and the winners playing at 7 p.m.

The final games will be on Friday with the winner in the losers bracket and the loser of the semi final game in the winners bracket playing at 5 p.m.

The championship game will be played at 7 p.m. on Friday, but if the teams are tied with one loss a final game for the zone championship will be played at 5 p.m. on Saturday.

The Goodland American Legion were to play Norton in a double-header on Thursday at Memorial Field.

Three Goodland boys will be competing July 26-31 at the 45th USA Track and Field National Junior Olympic Championships to be held in Wichita.

Goodland Coach Kent Teeter said the three boys competed in the regional qualifying track and field meet in Lawrence last weekend. Athletes finishing in the top five in each event qualified for the upcoming national USATF meet in Wichita he said.

Dax Ruhs finished third in the high jump in the 15 and 16 intermediate division with a jump of 5 feet 8 inches. He was fifth in the javelin with a throw of 136 feet.

Koal Artzer finished fourth in the high jump in the 13 and 14 youth division with a jump of 5'.

Trey Teeter finished second in the javelin in the 13 and 14 youth division with a throw of 128'.

Coach Teeter said the Goodland Youth Track and Field Meet will be held Saturday at the Goodland High School Track.

Any student from Kindergarten up to seniors in high school will be competing.

Registration begins at 8 a.m. Field

events begin at 9:30 a.m. and track events begin at 11 a.m.
