

# Cowgirls golf team winners at Lakin Broncs tournament

The Cowgirls golf team won the Lakin tournament on Saturday and four varsity girls medaled in the top 15, and two junior varsity medaled.

“Our girls had a tremendous day of golf on Saturday,” said Coach Connie Livengood. “They placed first as a team and medaled four girls in the top 15, and two junior varsity players medaled.

“The girls played very well, and had several personal bests and really just had some good quality golf.”

Jazz Weis played exceptionally well and won the tournament with an 84, Livengood said, and Weis chipped one in for a first time eagle.

Emily Purvis continues to be consistent and shot an even 100 for a personal best, Livengood said. Purvis placed Eighth for a medal.

Courtney Cowan shot a 101 for her personal best. Cowan placed 11th for a medal.

Jordan Knitig shot a personal best and lit up on the back side for a 105. Knitig placed 13th for a medal.

Megan Siruta is pretty consistent and we know she can do better, Livengood said, she sot a 110.

Shaina Varney got back on track with a 113.

“It is nice to know we can rely on different people at different times,” Livengood said, “and if they stay focused and play as a team they can really do even better down the stretch. Depends on how they want to finish and how badly they want to win. The girls put pressure on some teams, and it will be interesting on how we finish out the tournaments to come.”

In the junior varsity part of the tournament Kristi Stasser was Second with 115, and Miranda Hernandez was Third with 117.

Goodland won the tournament with a team total of 390. Syracuse was a close second with 391, Larned was third with 409, Holcomb fourth, 427 and Lakin fifth 468.
