

Cowgirls lose to Bluejays in Class 3A sub-state

The Cowgirls volleyball season came to a quick end Saturday afternoon at the hands of the top-seeded Cimarron Bluejays in the first round of the Class 3A sub-state at Max Jones Fieldhouse.

Cimarron came in as the No. 1 seed with a record of 34-3 and the Cowgirls were the No. 8 seed at 13-19.

In the first game the Cowgirls fell behind 13-9, but battled back to tie the game at 14-14. However the Bluejays were able to get a lead and hold it to win 25-18.

In the second game the Cowgirls took a 3-0 lead, but the Bluejays were able to cut that down and tie the game at 5-5. For several point the lead was tied or one point for either side. The Bluejays led 10-7, and were able to hold the lead to win the game 25-18 and the match to advance.

In the other first round games Kismet-Southwestern Heights defeated Lakin 25-11 and 25-12. Phillipsburg defeated Norton 25-10 and 25-10. Holcomb upset Scott City 25-17, 23-25 and 25-16.

In the second round Cimarron defeated Kismet 25-22 and 25-12 to advance to the championship.

Phillipsburg defeated Holcomb 25-7 and 25-22 to advance to the championship.

The Bluejays took the Panthers to three games, but lost 2-1. Phillipsburg won the first game 25-12, Cimarron won the second game 23-25, and Phillipsburg won the third in a close game 25-23. The Panthers are the sub-state champions and will advance to the Class 3A state volleyball championships to be held in Salina on Friday and Saturday.

The Cowgirls played hard and had good performances from Taryn Bedore, Paige Phillips, M-Lynn Hinger, Berkley White, Brianna White, Kate-Lynn King and Ellie House.
