The head coach for the Mustangs is Gary Winter. The next wrestling match for the Mustangs is at 9 a.m. on Saturday at the Hugoton Invitational.



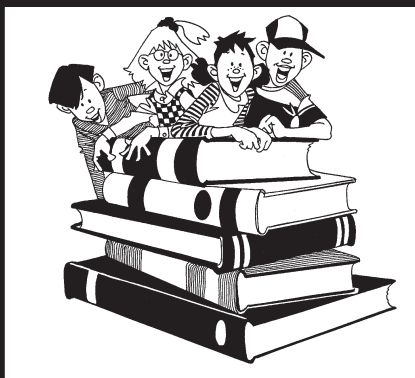
Cade Mayer, (right) wrestler at Grant Junior High, in his match against Holcomb Saturday at the Mustang Invitational. Mayer placed third.

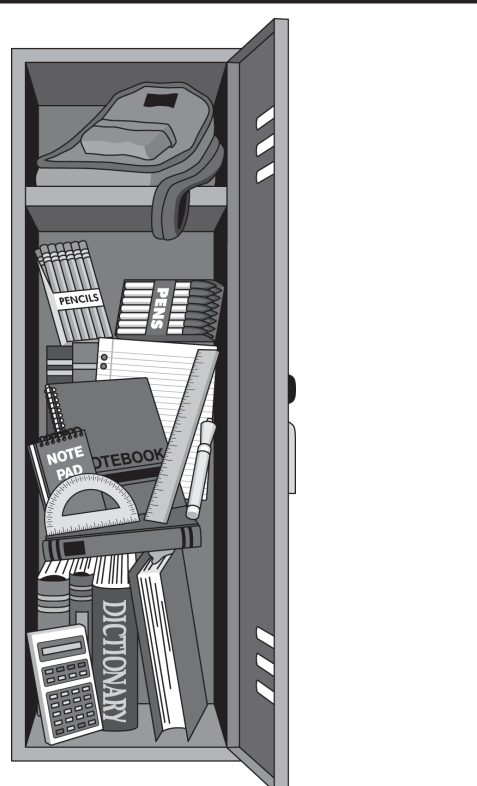
