Toys 4 Tots helps 271 kids get presents

A Big Thank You goes out to the community for Toys 4 Tots from the Goodland Kiwanis Club that helped provide toys for 271 kids this year.

People in the community again helped Kiwanis with Toys purchased all locally.

We are so grateful our club started the Flag Project 3 years ago to help with Toys 4 Tots, said Brad L. Schields, Kansas Kiwanis District Governor. When the club initially started the project we wanted a way to fund Toys 4 Tots and are so lucky the community has accepted the Service and Fundraising project.

For \$30 per year the club will place a flag in your yard or business 5 times a year on certain holidays plus 9/11.

Those funds are used locally to help pay for things on a yearly basis. Some uses are, Toys 4 Tots approximately \$3000, purchased part of the playground equipment at Steever Park \$8000, graduating Seniors from Goodland High School \$9000, help fund School clubs \$3000 and other things to many to mention that we fund \$4000 approximately.

So again we want to Thank You that have helped our Service Club with the Flag

Project, Hamburger Shack and Demolition Derby we do every year.

As you can see we try to do a lot with our community and our motto is "Children Priority One."

Our club meets every Tuesday for lunch at the Northwest Kansas Technical College student union so feel free to come join us and check us out. The Goodland club is the second largest club in the State of Kansas with 81 members. 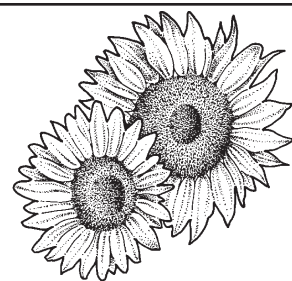


Gifts were separated by age and stacked on tables and shelves awaiting the distribution to the families and kids.



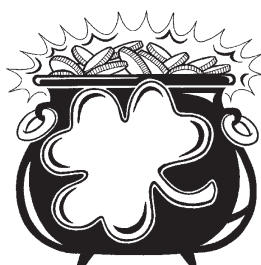
