Consumers throughout Kansas have been receiving cell phone text messages that claim they have won a Walmart gift card. The texts claim that the consumer has won a free gift card. They instruct you to click on a link and enter some information.

Unfortunately, there is no gift card. It is a scam to steal your credit card number and other personal info which will expose you to possible identity theft.

This scam has several versions. In one, the text reads "You just won a free \$1000 Walmart Gift Card, enter crease in scam text messages refer-"1000" at LINK." In another, it says: "Walmart \$1000 gift card for the first 1000 users to go to LINK and enter code 2938." The texts use dif-
