And ten years from now, I think I'll be... a mechanic.

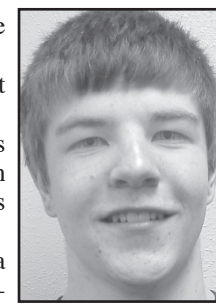

Activities involved in at GHS: X-pressos, Band, Jazz Band, Golf, and AFS

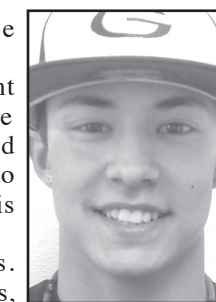
My choices of movies, music, books and games (be specific)... I enjoy reading historical fiction, and I enjoy playing most board games.
