

Goodland Swim Club picks up another victory at Wray swim meet

It was hot in Wray, Colo., on Saturday for the second swim meet of the season for the Goodland Swim Club and the competition was tough with a lots of close races. They won easily with 302 points. Swimmers won 17 individual and six relay races. The 15-18 mixed A team freestyle and medley relays set pool records. The 200-yard freestyle team won (1:47.02) with Holton Witman, Taryn Bedore, Zach Miller and Ian Bonsall swimming. In the 200-yard medley the same swimmers beat the pool record by eight seconds (1:47.07).

The club will be at Colby on Saturday. Ethan McDaniel (8 and under boys) was again a three time winner, winning the 50-yard freestyle (42.37), 25-yard freestyle (18.55) and 25-yard butterfly (21.22).

Rachel Witman (9-10 girls) also won all of her races the 25-yard backstroke (18.91), 25-yard butterfly (18.65) and the 100-yard individual medley (2:18.11).

Gantzen Miller (8 and under boys) was a winner in the 25-yard backstroke (25.05) and 100-yard individual medley (2:18.11).

Taryn Bedore won the 100-yard freestyle (1:03.14) and the 50-yard freestyle (27.68).

Winning one race each were Devinee Borgmann (11-12 girls) 50-yard freestyle (31.87), Ellie McDaniel (11-12 girls) 100-yard freestyle (1:15.58), Levi House (11-12 boys) 50-yard butterfly (41.29), Peyton Sieck (11-12 boys) 50-yard freestyle (32.68), Dusty Johnson (13-14 boys) 100-yard backstroke (1:20.21), Bonsall (15-18 boys) 50-yard freestyle (24.53), Zach Miller (15-18 boys) 100-yard breaststroke (1:16.53).

Other relay winners were the 8 and under boys A team 100-yard freestyle relay (1:38.29) with Ethan McDaniel, Gantzen Miller, Linkon Cure and Devontey Hardy swimming. Also 8 and under boys won the 100-yard medley (1:57.44) with Linkon Cure, Gantzen Miller, Ethan McDaniel and Hardy swimming.

The 11-12 girls 200-yard freestyle relay (2:30.09) won with Hannah Eslinger, Kaitlyn Townsend, Ellie McDaniel and Borgmann swimming and the 11-12 boys

200-yard freestyle relay also won (2:33.72) with Levi House, Chase Johnson, Peyton Sieck and Ryan Volk swimming.

In 8 and under girls Lindsey Cure was second in the 50-yard freestyle (43.49), second in the 25-yard freestyle (19.74) and fourth in the 25-yard backstroke (26.02) and Sydney Hahn third in the 50-yard freestyle (47.53), third in the 25-yard freestyle (20.07) and fifth in the 25-yard backstroke (26.81).

The 8 and under girls 100-yard freestyle relay was second (1:47.27) with Sydney Hahn, Olivia Bassett, Lindsey Cure and Vivian Soloman swimming.

In 8 and under boys Gantzen Miller was third in the 25-yard breaststroke (36.69); Hardy fourth in the 50-yard freestyle (51.17), fourth in the 25-yard freestyle (21.90) and fourth in the 25-yard backstroke (31.27); and Dexter Dautel fifth in the 25-yard backstroke (31.72).

The 8 and under boys B team 100-yard freestyle relay was fourth (2:27.33) with Dautel, Blair Linin, Walker Eslinger and Eli Green swimming.

In 9-10 girls Peri Sieck was fourth in the 100-yard freestyle (1:29.67), fifth in the 25-yard butterfly (22.46) and sixth in the 100-yard individual medley (1:52.50); Lauren Cure was fifth in the 25-yard freestyle (18.81) and sixth in the 25-yard backstroke (24.68); and Rebecca Lockhart was sixth in the 25-yard freestyle (18.82).

The 9-10 girls 100-yard freestyle relay was second (1:16.34) with Rachel Witman, Lauren Cure, Rebecca Lockhart and Peri Sieck swimming.

The 9-10 girls 100-yard medley was first (1:33.05) with Peri Sieck, Rebecca Lockhart, Rachel Witman and Lauren Cure swimming.

In 9-10 boys Leyton Cure was third in the 100-yard freestyle (1:29.77), second in the 25-yard freestyle (15.66) and fourth in the 25-yard butterfly (24.80).

In 11-12 girls Borgmann was third in the 50-yard butterfly (35.06); Ellie McDaniel was third in the 50-yard freestyle (34.18); Chalee Luther was second in the 100-yard freestyle (1:15.62) and second in the 50-yard breaststroke (46.09); and

Hannah Eslinger fifth in the 50-yard breaststroke (46.58).

In 11-12 boys House was second in the 50-yard freestyle (32.90) and first in the 100-yard individual medley (1:32.02); Peyton Sieck was second in the 100-yard freestyle (1:18.72) and second in the 100-yard individual medley (1:32.47); Powell Sieck was fourth in the 50-yard freestyle (34.84), fifth in the 50-yard backstroke (46.4) and third in the 50-yard butterfly (45.22); Austin Hahn sixth in the 100-yard freestyle (1:26.33) and third in the 50-yard breaststroke (51.20); Ryan Volk sixth in the 50-yard butterfly (59.46) and fourth in the 100-yard individual medley (2:05.72); and Chase Johnson fifth in the 50-yard breaststroke (53.89).

The 11-12 boys 200-yard medley was second (3:40.40) with Powell Sieck, Ryan Volk, House and Champ King swimming.

The 11-12 mixed 200-yard freestyle relay was fourth (3:48.08) with Leyton Cure, Annika Linin, Savannah Soloman and Jack Daise swimming.

The 11-12 mixed 200-yard medley was third (3:20.31) with Chase Johnson, Austin Hahn, Peyton Sieck and Teryn Teeter swimming.

In 13-14 girls Kinsey Volk was fifth in the 100-yard butterfly (1:57.52) and Sianna Miller sixth in the 100-yard backstroke (1:38.31).

The 13-14 girls 200-yard freestyle relay was fifth (3:01.21) with Kinsey Volk, Sianna Miller, Paetyn Barricklow and Lindsey Geeska swimming.

The 13-14 girls 200-yard medley was sixth (2:29.58) with Barricklow, Sianna Miller, Kinsey Volk and Geeska swimming.

In 13-14 boys Dusty Johnson was third in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:29.81) and third in the 200-yard individual medley (3:16.09) and Simon Bassett sixth in the 100-yard freestyle (1:17.20) and fourth in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:35.40).

The 13-14 boys 200-yard freestyle relay was second (2:11.12) with Dusty Johnson, Powell Sieck, Simon Bassett and Hagan Hoss swimming.

Here's How It Works:

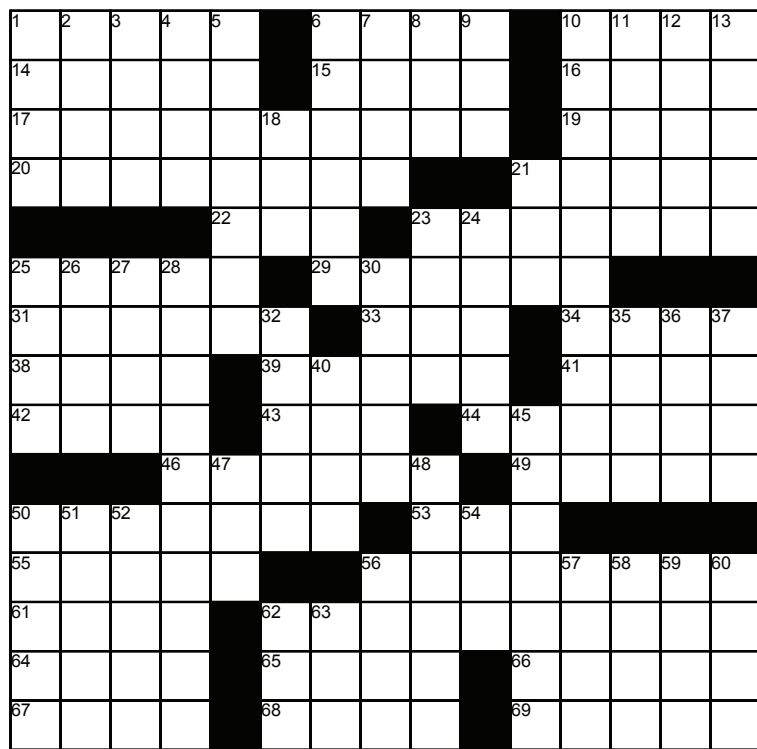
