

While farmers are taking to the fields early for the 2012 wheat crop, last Tuesday the USDA forecasted the Kansas crop at 387 million bushels, unchanged from the May estimate, but 40% more than the 2011 crop. If realized, this would be the highest production since 2003. Farmers are expected to harvest an average 43 bushels per acre from 9 million acres in Kansas.

2011 Kansas Department of Agriculture Statistics: Sumner County was the top producing county in the State with 10.5 million bushels. McPherson County was the second leading producer with 8.9 million bushels, followed by Sherman County with 7.4 million bushels, Mitchell County with 7.3 million bushels, and Reno County with 6.7 million bushels.






