

Goodland swimmers on winning streak

The Goodland Swim Team traveled to Colby Saturday and won for the third time this season with 256 points. Swimmers set six individual and two relay records. They won 16 individual and six relay races. These races were in meters.

The swim club will compete in Burlington Saturday.

Ethan McDaniel (8 and under boys) won all of his races and set two pool records; 50-meter freestyle (42.79) new pool record, 25-meter freestyle (19.10) and 25-meter butterfly (42.79) new pool record.

Ian Bonsall (15-18 boys) also broke two records in the 100-meter freestyle (59.61) new pool record and in the 50-meter freestyle (26.41) new pool record.

Rachel Witman (9-10 girls) won two of her events, the 25-meter backstroke (21.02) new pool record and the 25-meter butterfly (20.02).

Taryn Bedore (15-18 girls) was a two time winner in the 100-meter freestyle (1:09.84) and in the 50-meter freestyle (30.07) new pool record.

Levi House (11-12 boys) won three gold medals swimming the 100-meter freestyle (1:22.41), 50-meter butterfly (44.53) and 100-meter individual medley (1:43.46).

Winning one race each were Linsey Cure (8 and under girls) 25-meter freestyle (22.28), Gantzen Miller (8 and under boys) 25-meter backstroke (27.84), Chalee Luther (11-12 girls) 100-meter freestyle (1:23.62) and Zach Miller (15-18 boys) 100-meter breaststroke (1:25.40).

The 8 and under boys 100-meter medley (2:26.62) smashed the record by almost 14 seconds with Dexter Dautel, Grantzen Miller, Ethan McDaniel and Cole Linton swimming.

Holton Witman, Bedore, Zach Miller and Bonsall continued their record setting by beating the 15-18 mixed 200-meter freestyle relay (1:56.23) new pool record by almost seven seconds.

In 8 and under girls Lindsey Cure was also second in the 50-meter freestyle (50.24) and second in the 25-meter backstroke (27.04) and Mya Nemechek was third in the 50-meter freestyle (51.24), second in the 25-meter freestyle (22.91) and fourth in the 25-meter backstroke

(29.53).

The 8 and under girls 100-meter freestyle was second (1:57.13) with Lindsey Cure, Olivia Bassett, Nemechek and Vivian Soloman swimming.

In 8 and under boys Devontey Hardy was fourth in the 50-meter freestyle (57.01), fifth in the 25-meter freestyle (25.15) and fourth in the 25-meter backstroke (34.68); Gantzen Miller was fourth in the 25-meter breaststroke (40.81); and Linkon Cure was fifth in the 25-meter backstroke (36.43).

The 8 and under boys 100-meter

freestyle A team was first (1:42.58) with Ethan McDaniel, Gantzen Miller, Linkon Cure and Hardy swimming.

The 8 and under boys B team was fourth (2:33.80) with Dautel, Walker Eslinger, Linton and Blair Linin swimming.

In 9-10 girls Rachel Witman was also fourth in the 25-meter freestyle (18.46) and Peri Sieck was third in the 100-meter freestyle (1:43.16) and fourth in the 25-yard backstroke (23.31).

The 9-10 girls 100-meter freestyle was second (1:22.68) with

Rachel Witman, Peri Sieck, Rebecca Lockhart and Lauren Cure swimming.

The 9-10 girls 100-meter medley was first (1:47.73) with Nemechek, Rebecca Lockhart, Peri Sieck and Annika Linin swimming.

In 11-12 girls Chalee Luther was also second in the 50-meter

backstroke (44.68) and third in the 50-meter breaststroke (50.63) and Ellie McDaniel was third in the 100-meter freestyle (1:26.07), third in the 50-meter freestyle (39.22) and fourth in the 100-meter individual medley (1:46.71).

The 11-12 girls 200-meter freestyle was third (2:54.81) with Chalee Luther, Hannah Eslinger, Kaitlyn Townsend and Ellie McDaniel swimming.

The 11-12 girls 200-meter medley was third with Townsend, Rachel Witman, Chalee Luther and Ellie McDaniel swimming.

In 11-12 boys Peyton Sieck was second in the 100-meter freestyle (1:23.78), third in the 50-meter freestyle (36.83) and third in the 100-meter individual medley (1:49.16); Powell Sieck was fifth in the 50-meter freestyle (39.80) and fifth in the 50-meter butterfly (51.34); and Chase Johnson was fourth in the 50-meter breaststroke (59.37).

The 11-12 boys 200-meter freestyle was first (2:38.89) with House, Ryan Volk, Powell Sieck and Peyton Sieck swimming.

The 11-12 boys 200-meter medley was third (3:44.04) with Powell Sieck, Peyton Sieck, House and Champ King swimming.

The 11-12 mixed 200-meter freestyle was fourth (4:22.18) with Truman Hooker, Annika Linin, Jackson Daise and King swimming.

In 13-14 girls Sianna Miller was sixth in the 50-meter freestyle (36.03) and sixth in the 100-meter backstroke (1:49.06).

The 13-14 girls 200-meter freestyle was sixth (3:09.74) with Kinsey Volk, Savannah Soloman, Sianna Miller and Lindsey Geeska swimming.

The 13-14 girls 200-meter medley was sixth (3:27.60) with Sianna Miller, Hannah Eslinger, Kinsey Volk and Geeska swimming.

In 13-14 boys Dusty Johnson was second in the 100-meter backstroke (1:27.58), second in the 100-meter breaststroke (1:35.51) and second in the 200-meter individual medley

(3:20.10); Hagan Hoss was second in the 100-meter freestyle (1:14.39), second in the 50-meter freestyle (32.03) and second in the 100-meter butterfly (1:38.24); and Simon Bassett was sixth in the 100-meter freestyle (1:22.10) and sixth in the 100-meter breaststroke (1:46.26).

The 13-14 boys 200-meter freestyle was second (2:25.50) with Dusty Johnson, Hoss, Simon Bassett and Chase Johnson swimming.

The 13-14 mixed 200-meter medley was third (3:19.91) with Dusty Johnson, Simon Bassett, Hoss and Savannah Soloman swimming.

In 15-18 boys Bonsall was also second in the 100-meter backstroke (1:25.98); Zach Miller was fifth in the 50-meter freestyle (29.38) and third in the 200-meter individual medley (3:11.81); Holton Witman was third in the 50-meter freestyle (29.06), third in the 100-meter butterfly (1:22.18) and third in the 100-meter breaststroke (1:32.43); and Aaron Avelar was fourth in the 100-meter freestyle (1:16.62).

The 15-18 mixed 200-meter freestyle A team was first (1:56.23) new pool record with Holton Witman, Bedore, Zach Miller and Bonsall swimming.

The 15-18 mixed 200-meter freestyle B team was sixth (2:34.16) with Brooke Lockhart, Rachel Horney, Makayla Kennedy and Avelar swimming.

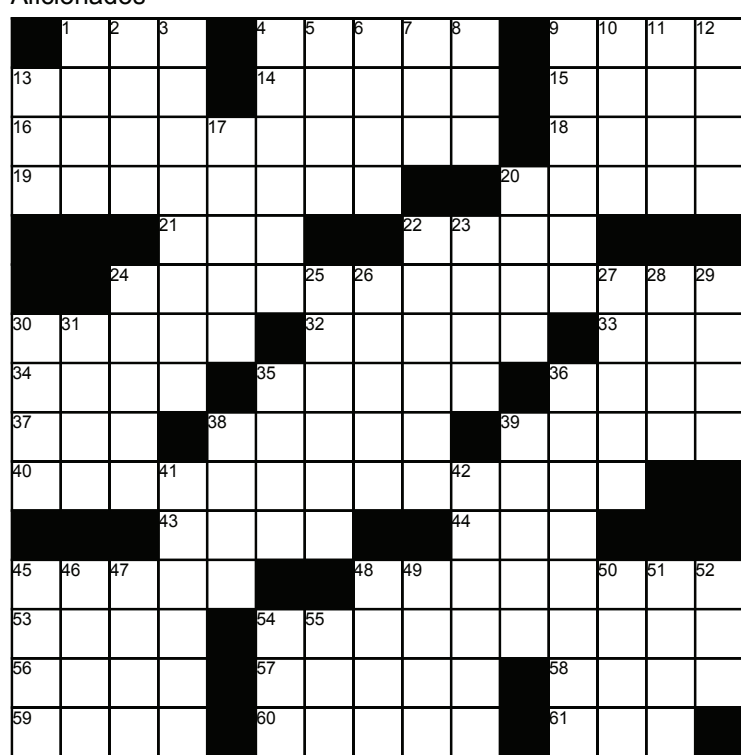
The 15-18 mixed 200-meter medley A team was first (2:25.98) with Bonsall, Zach Miller, Holton Witman and Bedore swimming.

Team results were Colby Swim Club second with 212 points, Burlington Swim Team third with 185.5, Holyoke Swim Club fourth with 169, Wray Swim Club with 168, Oberlin Swim Club with 157, Oakley Swim Team with 71 and Flagler Swim Club with 38.
