

Goodland athletes compete in national Junior Olympics

Four Goodland athletes placed in track and field events at the Amateur Athletic Union Junior Olympic Games in Houston on July 28.

Derek Brown tied for 20th in the high jump with a jump of 4 feet.

Trey Teeter placed 16th in the javelin with a throw of 123 feet, 1 inch and 60th in the 400-meter hurdles with a time of 1:07.23.

Koal Artzer tied for 12th in the high jump with a jump of 5 feet, 4 inches.

Arron Arteaga placed 13th in the pole vault with a vault of 10 feet, 20th in the 3,000-meter run with a time of 10:59.09 and 56th in the 800-meter run with a time of 2:25.97.

These four qualified for the national games at the Kansas/Missouri qualifier meet in Joplin earlier in July and competed at the Kansas meet in Towanda in June. Dax Ruhs also qualified for the national games in the javelin.
