Punt, Pass and Kick is a national program run by the National Football League at each of the 32 professional football teams. Each participant gets one punt, one pass and one place kick. These are judged on both distance and accuracy, with points deducted if a participant's ball goes

The initial round was held in Goodland earlier this year. Winners competed in the sectional competition in Littleton, Colo., on Oct. 14.

McDaniel qualified for Sunday's team competition, which will be held in the morning at the Bronco's training facility. She will also get to participate in a passing exhibition at halftime during the Bronco's game against Tampa Bay.

If she does well, McDaniel could qualify for the national competition, which will be held during a playoff game in January.
