

Cowboys win wrestling home opener

The Goodland High School wrestling team won 41-33 over the Decatur Community High School Red Devils in their first outing of the season Thursday at the Max Jones Fieldhouse.

The Cowboys started out strong in the lightweights. At 106 pounds, Tanner Gastineau won by fall over Daniel Lerew with 1:07 left in the first period.

Aaron Avelar, wrestling at 113, won a hard-fought match against Troy Juenemann 6-4 in overtime.

At 120, Tristan Cooper won by fall over Jude Wallinder with 24 seconds left in the first period.

Austin Hernandez, 126, was winning 2-0 going into the second, where he pinned Gabe Anderson 56 seconds in.

Brook Bahe, 132, won by fall over Kelly Brown after one minute and 40 seconds.

The Red Devils first win came at 138 pounds. Goodland's Riley Lopez lost by fall in the first period to Dayton Dreher.

Ricky Milke, 145, lost by fall to Chris Anderson in the third round.

At 152, Drew House lost by a 19-1

technical fall to Kade Brown.

John Peden, 160, beat Matt Glading in a 16-5 major decision.

Josh Whisnant, 170, lost an 8-2 decision to Rex Diederich.

Colton Cooper, 195, won a 10-0 decision over Grant Gilliam.

Decatur was open at 195, giving Tyler Gastineau the win, but the Cowboys were open at 220 and 285, giving wins to Channing Fortin and Cody Wurm, but it wasn't enough to overcome the Cowboys' lead.

At 113, Andy Windell won by fall over Justice Harris just 37 seconds into the first period.

D.J. Glassman lost by fall to Konnor Witt at 182.

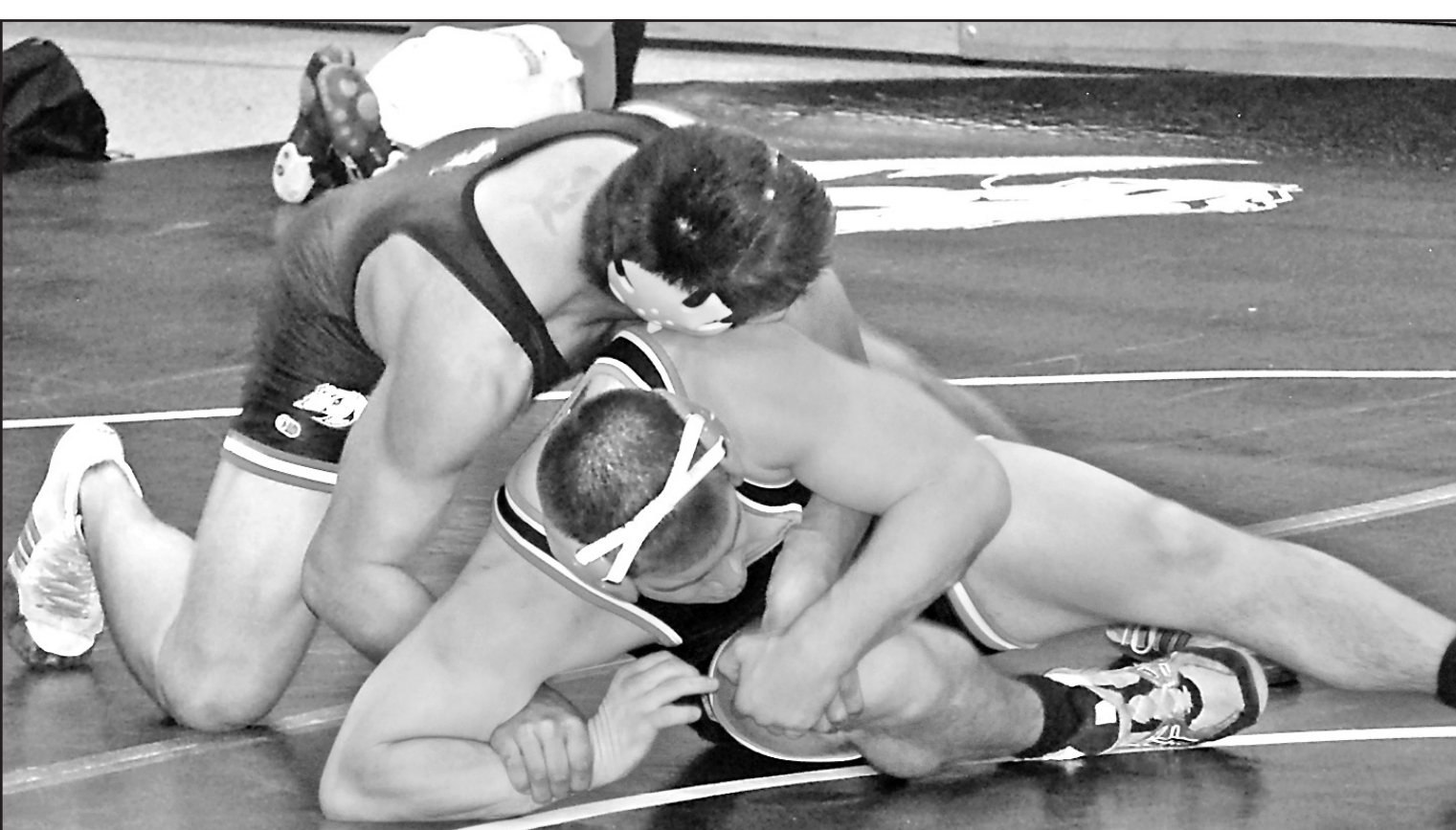
Thatcher Jones lost by fall to Ben Glading at 285.

The Northwest Kansas Technical College men's wrestling team lost a home match 33-19 to Neosho County Community College on Friday.

Mitchell Spiegel, 125, lost by fall.

Cody Tow, 125, lost by fall in the third period.

Tyler Hinton's match at 141 was tied 2-2 until Neosho's Terrence Moore escaped in the second. Hinton lost 7-3.

Jared Pratt, 149, was leading in the first period but ended up losing by fall.

Tyler Kimple, 165, was tied with Jonathan Barnett at 6. Kimple got a reverse to take an 8-6 lead. He was leading 10-8 in the third but Barnett

pinned him, winning the match.

The Mavericks dominated the last three matches starting with the 174-pound weight class. Dominic Bejarano took the lead in the third period and won 10-7.

At 184, Miguel Montelongo won a 10-4 decision and heavyweight Chris Kiel pinned his opponent in just 40 seconds.
