Governor facing stiff competition in November

The race for the top executive position in Kansas could either be a dead heat or swinging in favor of the Democratic challenger, depending on which polls you look at.

A Survey USA/KSN-TV poll from last week shows Paul Davis, the House Minority Leader, ahead of incumbent Gov. Sam Brownback 48 percent to 40 percent. However, the Brownback campaign rejected the results, and released an internal poll which puts the governor at 43 percent to Paul Davis'

With the election coming up on Tuesday, Nov. 4, the Brownback campaign announced Friday it had agreed to four debates. The first will be fro 8 to 9 a.m. (Mountain Time) at the State Fair in Hutchinson on Saturday, broadcast on WIBW radio. The second will be aired on KWCH television on a date to be determined. The third will be Friday, Sept. 19, in Johnson County. The fourth will be from 11:40 to 12:15 p.m. at the Wichita Airport Hilton, and will be broadcast by a variety of Kansas stations.

Brownback himself will be in Goodland on House he sponsored legislation to curb abu-Sept. 16 for a fund raising luncheon at Northwest Kansas Technical College. The Davis campaign currently has no events scheduled

Davis, who hails from Lawerence, holds an undergraduate degree from the University of Kansas and a law degree from Washburn University. He owned a private law firm - Fagan, Emert & Davis - in Lawrence.

Davis was first elected to the Kansas House of Representatives in 2003. He was elected House Minority Leader in 2008. While in the



Student attends camp

Luke Hamilton, son of Mike and Krista Hamilton, could be encountered in spaceflight. The stress simuattended the Camp KAOS Space 101 program June 17-21at the Kansas Cosmosphere in Hutchinson. Luke Hamilton will be entering the eighth at Grant Junior High this fall.

Space 101 is a four-day, introductory astronaut training camp for students entering seventh and eighth grades emphasizing teamwork, leadership and problem solving. Developed by Cosmosphere staff, Camp KAOS science, technology, engineering, and math-based programs are nationally recognized for their ability to motivate campers to seek careers in science and aerospace-related industries.

Participants construct and launch rockets, attend interactive briefings with Cosmosphere space science educators, tour the world-renowned Hall of Space Museum and train on Cosmosphere spaceflight simulators. The week culminates with a team-based mission in the Cosmosphere's Falcon III, most realistic space shuttle simulator outside of NASA where they pilot a low-Earth orbit mission – and the monitoring of another team's shuttle flight in Mission Control.

Cosmosphere spaceflight simulators challenge campers. The centrifuge is a rotating device that tests physical reactions to typical g-forces encountered during launch and reentry of spacecraft. The multiaxis trainer spins riders 360 degrees in multiple directions while simulating tumble maneuvers that

lator incorporates external stimuli into a mission to replicate potential stressful situations a person might encounter during spaceflight. The Falcon IIIsimulates launch, orbit, satellite deployment, reentry and landing of a space shuttle.

The Cosmosphere offers camp programs for students as young as those entering second grade, and on through high school. Camps are available for adults, including the Intergenerational Camp Experience for adults and their children or grandchildren. Additional camp experiences are offered for groups, and schools can custom-design curriculum based on state education standards. The Cosmosphere also has programs designed specifically for Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Webelos and the American Heritage Girls.

The Cosmosphere's Camp KAOS program features five progressive levels for students entering seventh grade. Campers begin with Space 101 and 201, which are held at the Cosmosphere and visit other nearby facilities. They move on to Space 301, which includes a trip to Johnson Space Center in Houston, Texas for a behind-the-scenes tour of NASA's astronaut training facilities. Those who progress to Space 401 travel to Kennedy Space Center in Florida, where campers experience NASA launch facilities. The most advanced campers in Space 501 focus on emerging space technology facilities in California.

The irony of U.S. foreign policies

At the start of classes one year ago, I had to explain to my students why the United States appeared to be on the verge of going to war against the Syrian government. At the beginning of this semester, exactly one year later, I'm having to explain to my students why the United States may be on the verge of going to war against Syrian rebels. Already, U.S. planes and missiles have been attacking the socalled Islamic State (ISIS) forces in northern Iraq. Given the threat of a genocidal campaign against Yazidis and other minorities and the risks of ISIS control expanding into the Kurdish region, even some of those normally averse to unilateral U.S. military intervention abroad have considered it the lesser of two evils.

Within days, however, there were already indications of "mission creep," as what had been officially declared an exclusively defensive mission turned offensive when the United States provided air support for Kurdish and Iraqi forces. It is not surprising, therefore, that there is skepticism regarding this use of military force. Even if one can make a convincing strategic case for such a military operation, the failure of President Obama to go before Congress for authorization of this renewed military intervention in Iraq is extremely disturbing.

Ironically, President Obama has been getting high-profile criticism from those wishing he had been more aggressive with projecting American military power. For example, in a well-publicized interview in The Atlantic, former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton blamed the rise of ISIS on Obama's failure to sufficiently arm and support the so-called moderate rebels of the Free Syrian Army (FSA).

Such a charge defies logic, however. The FSA consists of literally hundreds of separate militia without a central command, largely composed of relatively inexperienced fighters, who would have been no match for the well-armed, experienced, disciplined fighters of ISIS, regardless of the amount of weapons the U.S. might have provided. In fact, it was an awareness of ISIS's potential dominance of the Syrian rebel movement that served as an important reason why the Obama administration didn't go beyond the relatively limited arming and training of a few small groups affiliated with the FSA.

In any case, ISIS has found an even stronger foothold in Iraq than Syria, a direct consequence of the U.S. invasion and occupation. In a profile of ISIS leader Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi, a one-time moderate Sufi turned Salafist extremist, the New York Times observed, "At every turn, Mr. Baghdadi's rise has been shaped by the United States' involvement in Iraq - most of the political changes that fueled his fight, or led to his promotion, were born directly from some

Ironically, the eventual demise of ISIS will more likely stem from the group's own fanaticism than from any action by Baghdad or the U.S. ISIS – which even the Al-Qaeda network believes is too extreme – sees not just those who aren't Sunni Muslims as "infidels," but anyone who doesn't subscribe to its extremist ideology. Since almost everyone under its rule is therefore at risk, the prospects of the Iraqi and Syrian people eventually rising up against ISIS is high. In fact, Syrian nonviolent activists have already been openly defiant of ISIS. Had the active nonviolent coalition groups in Syria received material or diplomatic support from the beginning, instead of Clinton's "moderate" rebels, they may have been able to prevent or mitigate the rise of ISIS altogether.

Massive Western military intervention will likely create a backlash that could strengthen political support for the extremists. The United States has been bombing Iraq on and off for nearly a quarter century and things have only gotten worse, for the people of Iraq, the security interests of Iraq's neighbors and, ultimately, for the United States. Just as Sunni tribal leaders were more effective than either U.S. forces or the Iraqi government in driving out Al-Qaeda from northwestern Iraq in 2007-2008, they may also be the key, along with nonviolent civil society, in ridding their region of ISIS and any other actual or potential threats.



Governor faces stiff competition

back. This group included former Senate President Dick Bond, former state board of education member Carol Linnens and former state Rep. Charlie Roth. The group said Gov. Brownback's tax plan, education cuts and other budget issues were the primary reason for the endorsement.

Running for lieutenant governor alongside Davis is Jill Docking, who currently serves on the University of Kansas Endowment board. She has also served on the Kansas Board of Regents.

Brownback, who grew up on a pig farm near Parker, is a Kansas State University graduate. He earned a law degree in 1982 from the University of Kansas. In 1986 he became secretary of the Kansas Board of Agriculture, then in 1994 he was first elected to the U.S. House of Representatives and later to the U.S. Senate. He was elected to the governor's office in 2010.

Central to the governor's campaign for re-election is an update of




