At Irwin Stadium in Oakley, the Plainsmen defeated Hoxie for the

second time this season, shutting out the Indians 22-0 after leading 14-0 at halftime. Oakley won 8-6 on Sept. 16.

Senior running back Calder Keller scored two of Oakley's three touchdowns, with senior quarterback Chase Sperber getting the other one on a 1-yard keeper. Both were double first-team all-league picks this year in their offensive positions and as defensive backs.

The Plainsmen, now 12-0, will
