It was "Pin City" on Thursday night for Coach Bill Johnson's Norton Community High School wrestling team as they pinned 11 of their 17 opponents in defeating Osborne 75-3 and Hill City 67-6.

Norton lost just three matches —all close. In fact, the differences totaled just five points.

"These weren't very exciting duals but we wrestled hard," said Coach Johnson. "It was a nice tuneup for us prior to the regional tournament.'

The feature event of the duals was Norton senior Jordon Haussermann's 152 pound match against Hill City senior Tanner Long. Until this week, Haussermann was ranked No. 6 in the state him 7-5. and Long is ranked No. 4. Long the mat for a 2-0 lead in the first 215. period. 


'PIN CITY'


