

# Jennings takes second in regionals

The Jennings boys basketball team lost to Weskan 64-51 during their last game in the regular season on Feb. 20. At the 1A Regional Basketball Tournament the Coyotes defeated Cheylin 73-24 in the first round on Feb. 23 and Brewster 63-62 in the semi-final round on Feb. 26. They lost to Herndon 66-56 on Feb. 28 in the final regional round.

**WESKAN**  
The Coyotes trailed by 1 point at the end of the first quarter and then were up by 1 point at half-time, only to fall behind in the third to lose the game in the fourth: 15-14, 31-30, 53-36, 64-51.

Adam Miller led scoring with 8 two-pointers and 2 free throws for 18 points. He was followed by Adam Wahlmeier with 14 points, Grant Bailey with 7, and Brett McKenna and Marcus McKenna with 6 apiece.

Rebounding honors went to B. McKenna and Miller with 6 apiece, followed by Bailey with 4, Nick Wahlmeier and A. Wahlmeier with 3 apiece, and M. McKenna and Kyle Kinser with 2 each.

Steals were made by Bailey, 3; M. McKenna and N. Wahlmeier, 2 apiece; and A. Wahlmeier, 1.

Bailey led assists with 6, followed by B. McKenna with 4, M. McKenna and A. Wahlmeier with 2 each, and N. Wahlmeier and Miller with 1 apiece.

Jennings led in every quarter: 11-3, 29-8, 56-12, 73-24.

Brewster led in the first three quarters, but then Jennings came from behind to take the win in the fourth: 23-16, 37-29, 54-43, 63-62.

Bailey led scoring for the Coyotes with 5 two-pointers and 4 three-pointers for 22 points. He was followed by A. Miller, 18 points; A. Wahlmeier, 12; M. McKenna, N. Wahlmeier and Kinser, 3 apiece; and B. McKenna, 2.
