Three of the state medal winners from the 1973 team are still living in Norton. Klein is night foreman at New Age Industrial Corp., Inc.; Whitney is physical plant supervisor senior at the Norton Correctional Facility and Washburn is owner of Washburn Construction and the Hillcrest Motel.

Ward sold Ward's Sports and Toys in Norton and is a sporting goods salesman in Erie, Colo. Sides is a Kansas State University graduate in veterinary medicine and practicing in Redman, Oregon.


Koel is chemistry professor at the University of Southern California in Los Angeles. Anderson is
