
Second, students must exhibit leadership by holding office or being in a leadership position. Applicants must also acquire three positive leadership recommendations from teachers, coaches and sponsors.

Character is the third criteria. Students

must have at least ten positive character references filled out by teachers, coaches and sponsors.

The fourth criteria includes both school activities and community service activities. Students must be involved in a minimum of twelve school activities in three different areas. Applicants must also accumulate at least eight different community service activities.
