

If the owner fails to commence repair or removal of such structure within that time period or fails to diligently prosecute the same until the work is completed, the governing body will cause the structure to be razed and the costs of the same shall be assessed on the tax rolls against said property.

The city clerk is directed to publish this findings and order in the official city newspaper one time and to mail a copy of this finding and order to all owner(s), occupant(s), agent(s), lienholder(s), and interested parties.
