Published in The Norton Telegram on Friday, July 2, 2004. (1T) NOTICE OF PLACES AND DATES OF REGISTRATION FOR PRIMARY ELECTION

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the voters of NORTON COUNTY, Kansas may register to vote at the following places during regular office hours: Norton City Office, Almaena City Office, Lenora City Office and Library and the Norton County Clerk's Office. At 5:00 p.m. on the 19th day of July, 2004, the books for registration of voters will close and will remain closed until the 4th day of August 2004.

A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or will have attained the age of 18 years at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Registration closes 14 days prior to every election.

When a registered voter changes residence from one precinct to another precinct, such voter must re-Register in order to be eligible to vote. Any person may apply in person, by telephone, or by mail to the county election officer to be registered. Application forms shall be provided by the county election officer upon request by the applicant. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.

When a registered voter fails to vote in two consecutive general elections, such voters name may be removed from the registration books and party affiliation lists. Such voter must re-register in order to be eligible to vote.
