In the top of the second inning, Norton added four more runs to take a 5-0 lead. Zach Bainter, Kaenon Keiswetter, Landon Hamel, Tyler Cook and Terrell Lane all walked; J.D. Gall singled; Landon Keiswetter walked and Bainter, Keiswetter, Hamel and Cook all scored.

Hill City scored two runs in the bottom of the second inning to cut the Norton lead to 5-2.

The Blue Jays extended their lead to 8-2 in the top of the third inning. Zach Bainter doubled, Kaenon Keiswetter singled, Cook walked, Lane tripled, Landon Keiswetter and Terrell both walked and Bainter, Keiswetter and Cook scored.

Hill City scored one run in the bottom of the stanza to make the final score 8-3 in favor of Norton.

Winning pitcher was Shirk. He allowed only two hits, walked four and struck out six batters.

Losing pitcher was McKeever. he gave up six Norton hits, walked nine and struck out three batters.

None of the Norton batters had more than one hit but Lane's triple and doubles by Zach Bainter, Shirk and Landon Keiswetter were the big hits for Norton.

GAME WITH RUSSELL

Norton scored four runs in the

top of the first inning against Russell. Cook and Shirk led off with walks, then Landon Keiswetter was hit by the pitcher to load the bases. Lane doubled, McKenna walked and Zach Bainter singled and Cook, Shirk, Keiswetter, Lane and McKenna all scored.

The Blue Jays added three more runs in the top of the second inning to extend their advantage to 8-0.

Cook was hit by the pitcher and advanced to first base, the Kaenon Keiswetter was also hit by a pitcher. Landon Keiswetter stepped to the plate and blasted a home run that scored all three runs.

Russell scored their first run in the bottom of the second inning to make it 8-1 and added three more tallies in the bottom of the third to make it an 8-4 contest.

Norton was unable to score again and Russell added one run in the fourth and three more in the fifth inning to tie the score at 8-4.

No runs were scored by either team in the sixth or seventh innings.

Norton recorded three hits in the game, nine Norton batters walked and three struck out. Hamel was the Norton pitcher.

Ochs was the Russell pitcher. Russell had 13 hits, two batters walked and ten struck out.

The big hit by Norton was the home run by Landon Keiswetter that scored three runs.
