The Almena City Council will hold a public hearing on Monday, September 13, 2004, at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall, 415 Main Street, Almena, Kansas, for the purpose of considering an application to be submitted to the Kansas Department of Commerce for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds under the Water/Sewer category.
