City Fireworks Ordinance

Published in The Norton Telegram on Friday, September 10, 2004. (1T)

ORDINANCE NO. 1536

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 7-305, OF THE NORTON CITY CODE RELATING TO THE SHOOTING OR FIRING OF FIREWORKS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1: Section 7-305 of the Code of the City of Norton is hereby amended to read as follows:

7-305 Fireworks.

A. The manufacture, sale and discharge of fireworks in the City shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the State Fire Marshall, as set out in the Kansas Administrative Regulations at 22-6-1 through 22-6-17. Such rules and regulations are hereby incorporated by reference as though set out in full herein.

B. Section 22-6-5 of the Rules and Regulations of the State Fire Marshall incorporation (in subsection A) above is hereby amended to read as follows:

The sale, offering for sale, and shooting or firing of fireworks of every nature, shall be conducted only during the days of July 1st through July 5th of each year, both dates inclusive. The physical shooting or firing of fireworks of every nature shall be prohibited between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. on July 1st through July 5th, except that on evening and early morning of July 4th and 5th the shooting or firing of fireworks may occur until 1:00 a.m.

Section 2: Section 7-305 is hereby amended.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication in the official city newspaper.
