

C-team Huskies played Quinter

The Northern Valley High School C-team basketball squad played a hard fought game but took a 57-42 loss to Quinter in the fifth place contest of the Joe Green Invitational Basketball Tournament on Dec. 30 at Hill City.

Bryce Marble led scoring for Northern Valley with 18 points, followed by Richie Kersch, nine points; David Harris, eight; Chase Miller, nine; Richie Kersch, five; Blake Johnson, one; and Chance Miller, two.

Top rebounding honors went to Marble with 10; Chase Miller, seven; Tony Simants, six; Harris, five; Johnson, four; Chance Miller, three; and Kersch, two.

Making assists were Harris, four; Marble, three; Kersch, two; and Johnson, one.

Johnson led steals with four; Kersch, two; and Chase Miller, Simants, Harris and Marble, each having one.

Northern Valley grabbed 37 rebounds to Quinter's 33.

Marble was named to the All-Tournament Team.

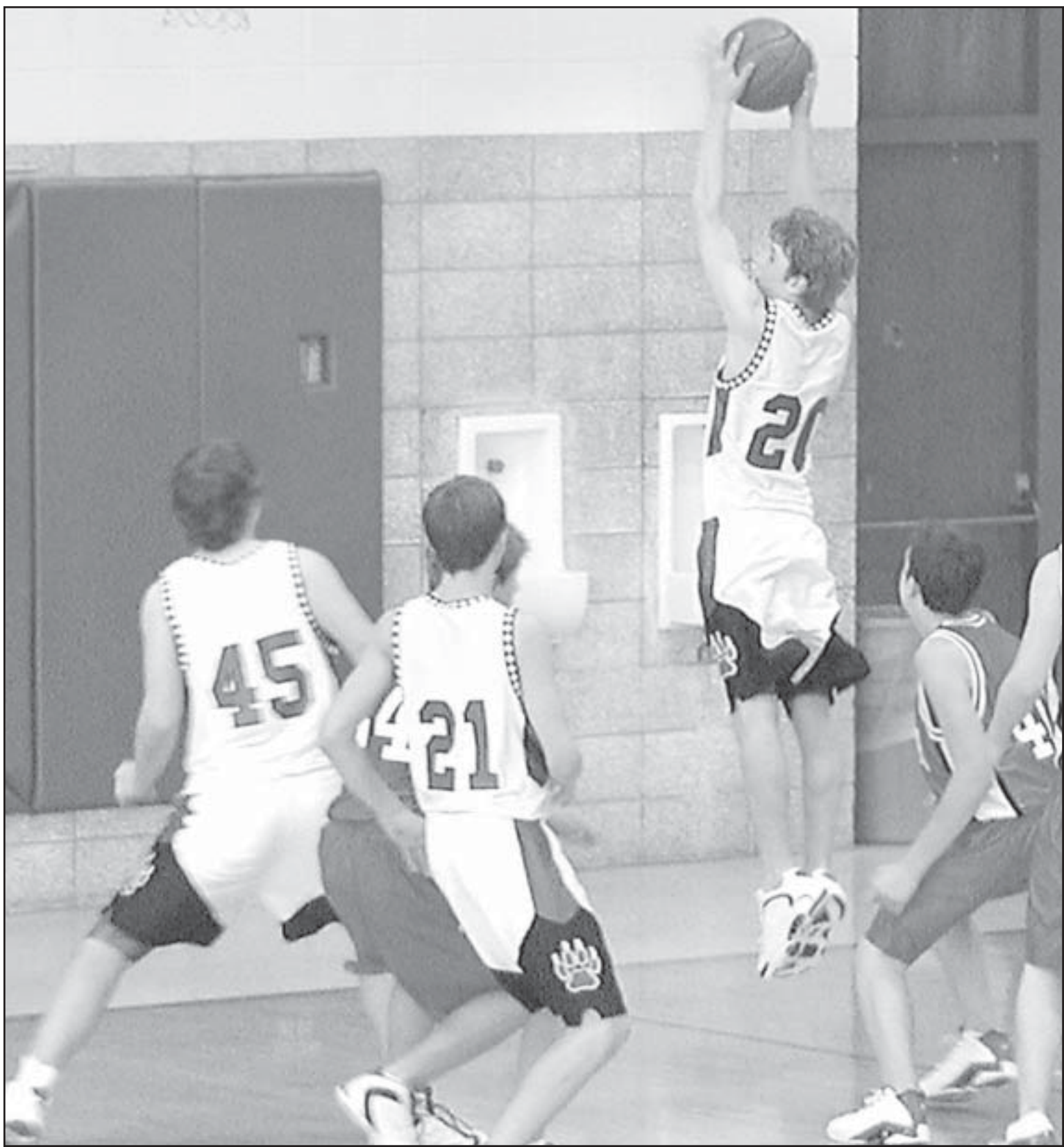
