Fresh off a main event win the previous night at The Speed Bowl in Red Cloud, Neb., Cory Struckhoff of Kensington held off challengers to win an exciting IMCA Stock Car feature at Elmwood Park Speedway on Saturday.

Bryan Lariviere of Wichita took the lead at the drop of the green with Struckhoff right behind. By lap 5, Tyler Hahn and Troy Attwood tagged the front running duo to make it a four car race. Then on lap 7, Struckhoff was able to get by Lariviere to take a lead he would not relinquish. Caution flags on laps 9 and 10 bunched the field with racing for positions all the way through the 14-car field. Lariviere stayed glued to Struckhoff's bumper the final 10 laps but just could not make the pass. Josh Hudson, Hahn, and Nathan Glendening made it a five car race the final few laps but Struckhoff held on to the checkers. Hudson made a charge to finish second with Hahn third. Heat race winners Lariviere and Glendening finished fourth and fifth.

David Murray Jr., Oberlin, continued his domination on the half-mile oval in the IMCA Modified division. Murray took over the lead from Brian Calhoun on lap 5 of the 20-lap main event and drove away for his sixth win in 9 races at Elmwood Park Speedway this season. Calhoun finished second, with Tim Watts, Roger Boland and heat one winner John Fose rounding out the top five. Murray won the other heat race.

Wade Wagenblast of Deshler, Neb., won his fourth IMCA Hobby Stock feature at Norton Saturday night. Phil Hinger of Plainville led the first 5 laps of the 15-lap race with Adam Balthazor giving chase. But Wagenblast worked his way through the field and took command on lap 6 and led the remaining distance to make his way to victory lane. Kelly Karnopp, who spun on lap 2 and

was sent to the tail end of the 15-car field, worked his way back up to second. Hinger finished third, followed by Brady Schoen and Balthazor. The race was red-flagged on lap 12 when Brandon Naasz of Downs rolled in turn 4. He was not injured but his car was done for the night. Heat race winners were Balthazor, Karnopp and Wagenblast.

Hometown duo Wes and Chuck Eagleburger found their way to the winner's circle for the third time this season at Norton. They led the first 2 laps before Mike Hockemeier and Jim Ellis passed them for the lead. But Hockemeier and Ellis had motor problems on lap 5 and came to a stop to bring out a caution. That gave the Eagleburgers the lead back and they held on for the win. Macy and Kimberly Thomas finished second, followed by Kirk Persinger and Justin Graham. The Eagleburgers, Jeff Kleen and Chad Engrim, and Hockemeier and Ellis were victorious in the three heat races.

A representative from Las Vegas Motor Speedway was on hand to give away T-shirts and tickets to the speedway.

Racing action returns to the big 1/2-mile oval during the Norton County Fair on Saturday and Sunday, July 30-31. The regular four divisions will run a regular show on July 30, starting at 7 p.m.. Then on Sunday, it will be the Third annual Bud Shoot-Out sponsored by Western Distributing of Norton. Added prize money will be up for grabs in all 4 divisions. Race time Sunday will be 6:30 p.m.
