The Huskies outscored the Warriors in the second period, 12-10, stayed even at 13-13 in the third and managed a 19-13 fourth quarter advantage which saw the game knotted at 56 when the fatal blow

was delivered at the buzzer.

Too, at the free throw line, the Warriors connected on 13 of 20, while the Huskies managed only 5 of 13.
