It has been determined that such request for release of funds will not constitute an action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment and, accordingly, the above-named has decided not to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (P.L. 91-190).

The reasons for such decision not to prepare such Statement are as follows: The implementation of this project will not adversely affect the environment.

An Environmental Review Record respecting the within project has been made by the above-named City which documents the environmental review of the project and more fully sets forth the reasons why such Statement is not required. This Environmental Review Record is on file at the above address and is available for public examination and copying, upon request, at the Almena City Clerk's Office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3 p.m.

No further environmental review of such project is proposed to be conducted, prior to the request for release of federal funds.

All interested agencies, groups, and persons disagreeing with this decision

are invited to submit written comments for consideration by the City to the Mayor. Such written comments should be received at PO Box 227, Almena KS 67622 on or before 15 days after date of this Notice. All such comments so received will be considered and the City will not request the release of federal funds or take any administrative action on the within project prior to the date specified in the preceding sentence.

NOTICE TO PUBLIC OF REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

The City of Almena will undertake the project described above with block grant funds from the Kansas Department of Commerce, under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The City is certifying to Commerce that the City of Almena and Gerald D. Wilson in his official capacity as Mayor, consent to accept the jurisdiction of the federal courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews, decision making, and action, and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval, the City may use the Block Grant Funds and Commerce will have satisfied its responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. Commerce will accept an objection to its approval of the release of funds and acceptance of the certification only if it is on one of the following bases: (a) that the certification was not in fact executed by the chief executive officer or other officer of applicant approved by Commerce, or (b) that applicant's Environmental Review Record for the project indicates omission of a required decision, finding, or step applicable to the project in the environmental review process. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedure (24 CFR Part 58), and may be addressed to the Kansas Department of Commerce, Small Cities CDBG Program, 1000 S.W.
