

Northern Valley Junior High girls win league meet, boys finish fourth

The Northern Valley Junior High track team competed in the Greater Northern Elementary League track meet in Logan on May 11.

The Husky girls had a great day, winning first place.

"The girls pulled off the triple crown, winning the league in volleyball, basketball and track," said Coach Jim Cole. "All nine of our junior high girls came home with at least two medals.

"Christina Anderson led the team by winning four first place medals. Alison Cole won three first place medals and one second, and set three league meet records this year."

The Northern Valley girls won four track meets during the season.

The Husky boys finished the league in fourth place as a team.

The sixth grade boys and girls combined to win the sixth grade division. The boys and girls won three track meets during the season.
