

Logan does well at state

Seven track and field athletes from Logan High School competed in the Kansas High School Track and Field Meet held Friday and Saturday in Cessna Stadium in Wichita.

Junior Tim McElroy scored the most points for the Trojans. He won the discus event with a throw of 160' on his final throw in the finals and placed fifth in the shot put with a heave of 49'6.5", which was just 1.75" out of fourth place.

Both of his efforts were better than in the regional meet where he had a discus throw of 151'1" and a shot put distance of 48'10".

On the strength of McElroy's performances, Logan placed 18th as a team. Palco was fifth, Brewstereighth, Kensington 10th.

Sophomore Zach Long was the only other Logan boy to compete. He placed 12th in the pole vault with a height of 11'.

"Tim did great," said coach Linda Nighswonger. "We were very excited for him. His personal record in the discus is 160'10" so he came close to that. He's only a junior so he's got another year to do well."

"Zach performed well. It was his first time at the state meet."

"He improved so much this year. His personal record is 11'6" and he's only a sophomore."

Junior Bethany Clements was the only medal winner for the Lady Trojans. She placed seventh in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:31.21.

Junior Anne Hartman placed sixth in her heat of the 200 meter dash on Friday with a time of 28.52 and missed qualifying for Saturday's finals by 36 hundredths of a second.

Logan also qualified two relay teams for the state meet. The four-some of senior Megan Brumbaugh, Clements, sophomore Shelley Kemper and Hartman was timed in 55.35 in the 400 meter relay on Friday but did not qualify for Saturday's finals.

The Lady Trojans' 1600 meter

relay team of Clements, sophomore Jenny Archer, Kemper and Hartman was timed in 4:29.45 and also did not qualify for the finals on Saturday.

"I was really happy so many of our athletes were able to compete in the state meet," said coach Linda Nighswonger.

"I thought our girls would run a little better than this meet is so much larger with so many distractions that it is sometimes hard to focus on what needs to be done. We had to make a change in one of our relay runners and that can make a difference."

"Some of the events were fairly close together for Anne so that could have affected her performances."

Northern Valley athletes vaulted, ran hurdles in State Track meet

Three Northern Valley High School boy and girl track athletes competed in the Class 1A State Track and Field Meet held Friday and Saturday in Cessna Stadium in Wichita.

Sophomore Joni Hilburn tied for eighth in the pole vault, just one place out of the points, with a height of 8'.

Senior Clarke Nelson competed in the pole vault and did not make opening height.

Senior Joey Copper ran the 110 meter high hurdles on Friday and appeared to have qualified for Saturday's finals but was disqualified on a technicality.

"Joni vaulted well," said coach Chuck Fessenden. "She vaulted 8'6" four times this season and 8' fourtimes. She is just a sophomore and will go higher next year."

"Clarke has had pole troubles recently. He broke his 13'6" pole so we got him a 14' pole, hoping he could go higher with it. He had trouble getting his steps down with the longer pole. He had no choice but to go with the longer one since he had broken his shorter pole. He'd cleared 12'8" this year which would have put him in third place."

"Joey was disqualified for not bringing his trailing leg over the hurdle. He normally runs in the middle of the track with someone on both sides of him and would not have that trouble. But, he was running in lane one and got over too far. He ran fast enough to qualify for Saturday's finals. It was too bad this happened to him but that

is the rules."

Copper, Nelson and Hilburn also competed in the state meet last year. Copper placed sixth in the triple jump and also competed in

the 110 meter hurdles. Nelson placed 10th in the pole vault with a 12' height. Hilburn tied for 10th in the pole vault with a height of 8'.




