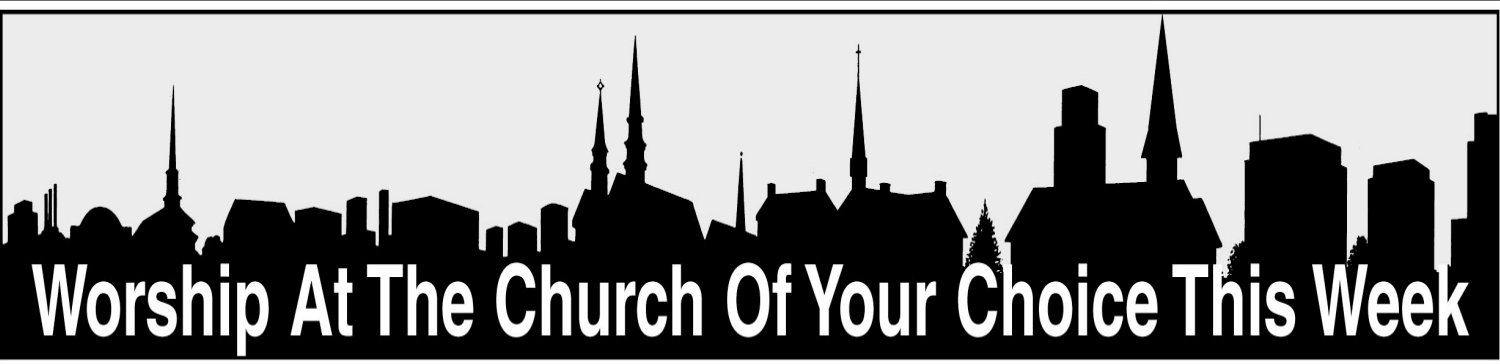
Kearney and Katherine Hicks was at Norton. Mary Keith was also at Kearney but is staying with her family for awhile. We hope they are all on their way to recovery.
