

ORDINANCE NO. 330
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE AMOUNT OF COURT COSTS ASSESSED BY THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS

WHEREAS, House Bill #2122 approved by the 2006 Kansas Legislature requires that in each case filed in Municipal Court charging a crime other than a non-moving traffic violation an additional sum of \$19.00 be assessed.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS:

Section One: That Section 9-112 of the Code of the City of Lenora, Kansas, concerning court costs in Municipal Court is amended by replacing the

existing section in its entirety with the following provision:

"9-112. COURT COSTS. In all cases wherein there is a finding of guilty, plea of guilty, plea of no contest, forfeiture of bond or a diversion before the Municipal Court of the City, an assessment of \$30.00 shall be imposed and collected for the cost of the administration of justice."

Section Two: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
